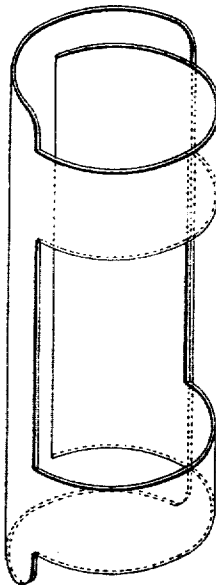

DESIGN FOR A CIGAR-WRAPPER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 24,308, dated May 14, 1895.

Application filed October 18, 1894. Serial No. 526,319. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PETER C. FULWEILER, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city and county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Cigar-Wrappers, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part of this specification.

The characteristic feature of the design consists in a tubular wrapper, one side of which comprises a semi-cylindrical part *a*, and the other side of which comprises narrow semi-circular strips *b* connecting the respective

edges of the part *a* in a manner to leave an intermediate opening, as shown most clearly in the drawing, which is a perspective view of the wrapper.

What I claim is—

The design for a cigar wrapper, substantially as herein shown and described.
