

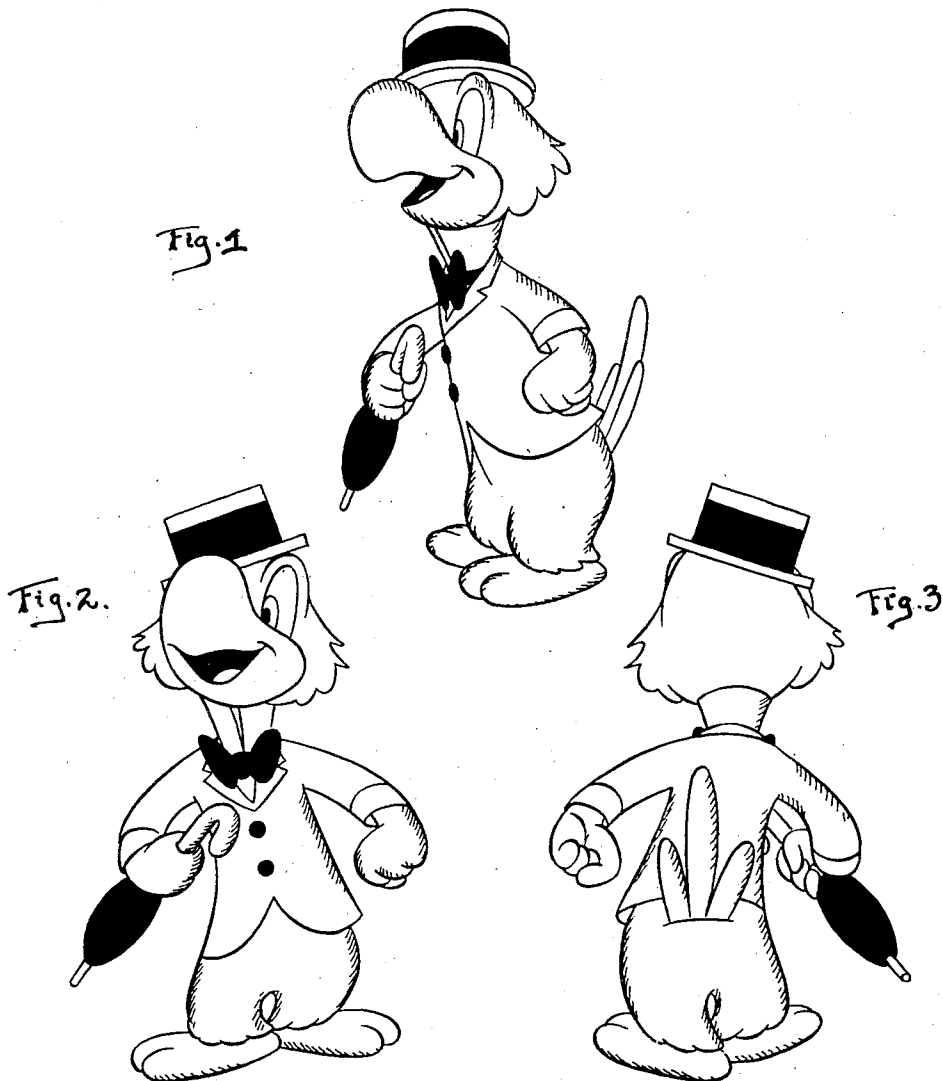

DESIGN FOR A DOLL OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter E. Disney, a citizen of the United States, residing at Hollywood, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Doll or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side perspective view;

Fig. 2 is a front perspective view, and

Fig. 3 is a rear perspective view of a doll or similar article, showing my new design.
