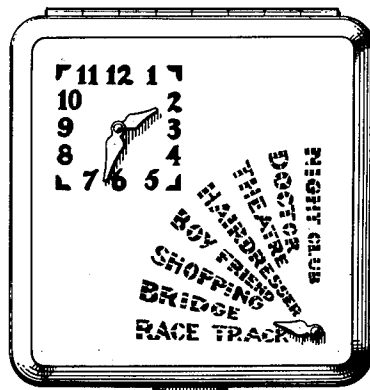

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max Kotler, a citizen of the United States, residing at Providence, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vanity Case or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of the vanity case showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a front edge view of the same.
