[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a game carrying strap assembly having plural loop ended straps, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a game carrying strap assembly having plural loop ended straps, embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevation being substantially the mirror image thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.

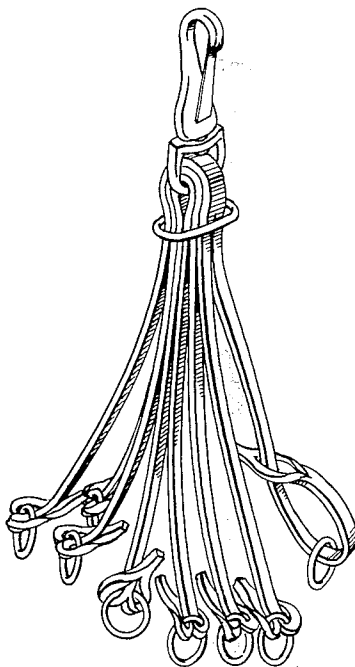

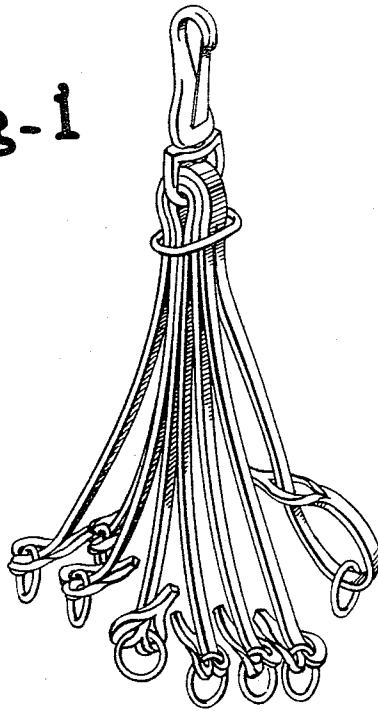

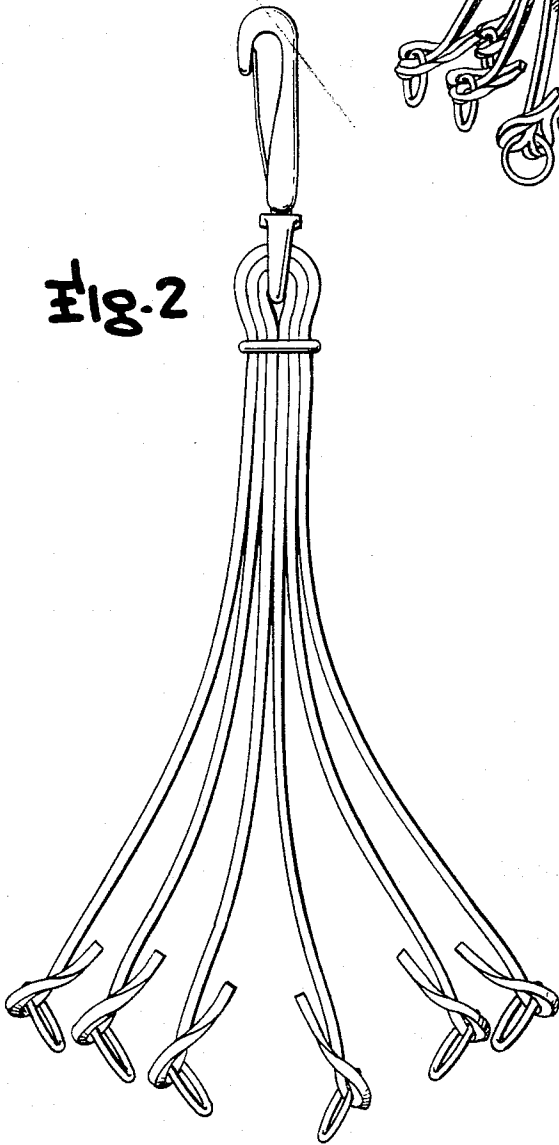
