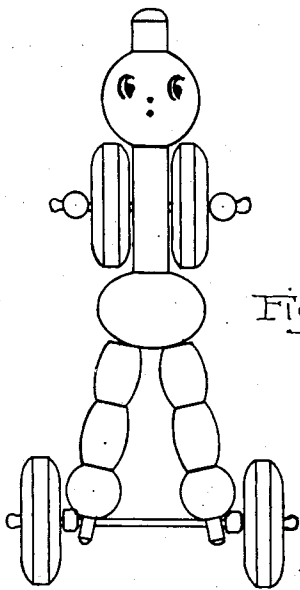

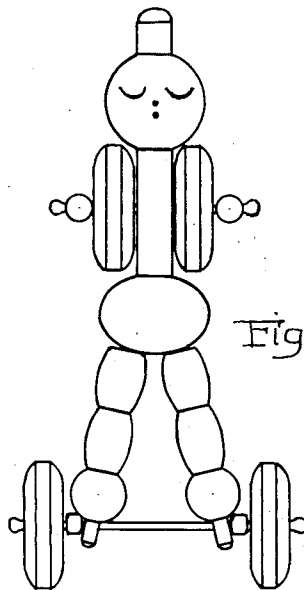

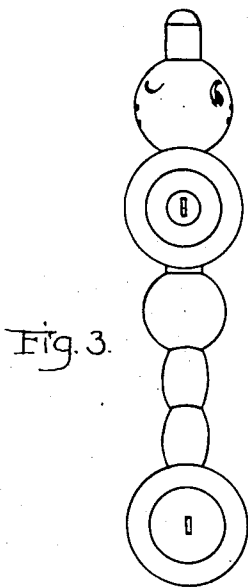

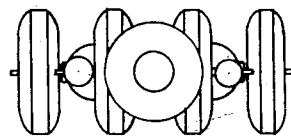

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Charles H. Pajeau, a citizen of the United States, residing at Evanston, Cook County, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Wheeled Toy Figure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front face view of a wheeled toy figure showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a rear face view thereof;

Figure 3 is a side elevational view, and

Figure 4 is a top plan view.
