



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Aida Azurdia de Berg, a citizen of Guatemala, residing at Antigua, Guatemala, in Central America, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Decorative Candle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
