(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a memorabilia home plate display case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an overall perspective view of the memorabilia home plate display case, showing commemorative pins displayed herein;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIGS. 3 and 4 are top and bottom views thereof, respectively;

FIG. 5 is a rear view;

FIGS. 6 and 7 are left and right side elevation views thereof, respectively;

FIG. 8 is an alternate embodiment for the memorabilia home plate display case, showing commemorative pins displayed therein;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the alternate embodiment; FIGS. 10 and 11 are top and bottom views thereof, respectively;


FIG. 12 is a rear view thereof of the alternate embodiment;

FIGS. 13 and 14 are left and right side elevation views respectively of the alternate embodiment; and,

FIG. 15 is a front elevation view of the alternate embodiment showing photographs and/or commemorative pins installed therein.

The handle, hinges, commemorative pins, photographs and wall mounts are shown for environmental purposes in dashed lines, and form no part of the claimed design.

























