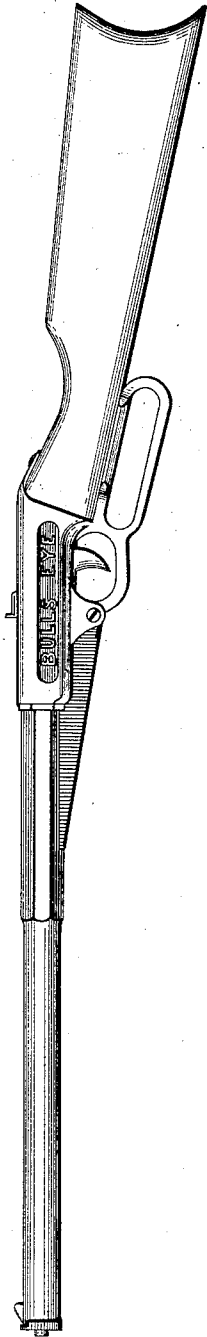

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ELBERT HAMILTON SEARLE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Air-Rifles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
