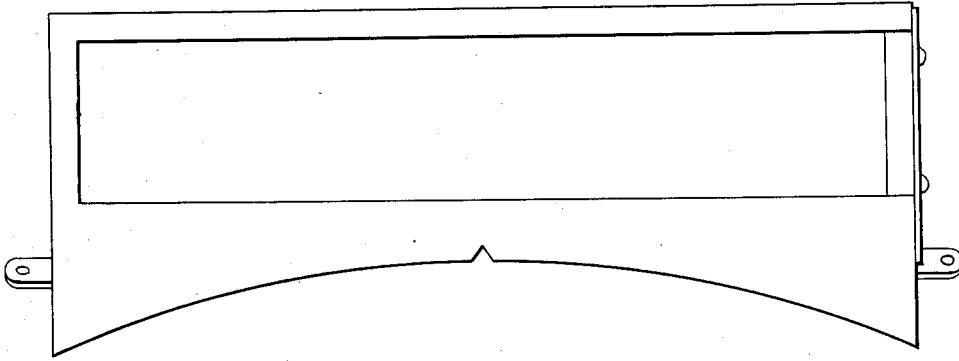

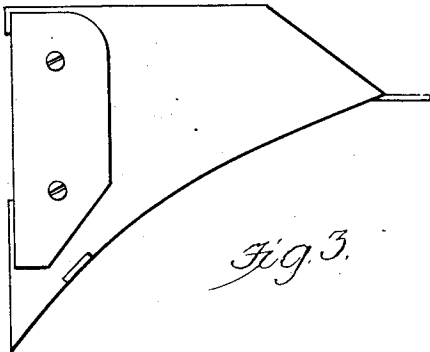
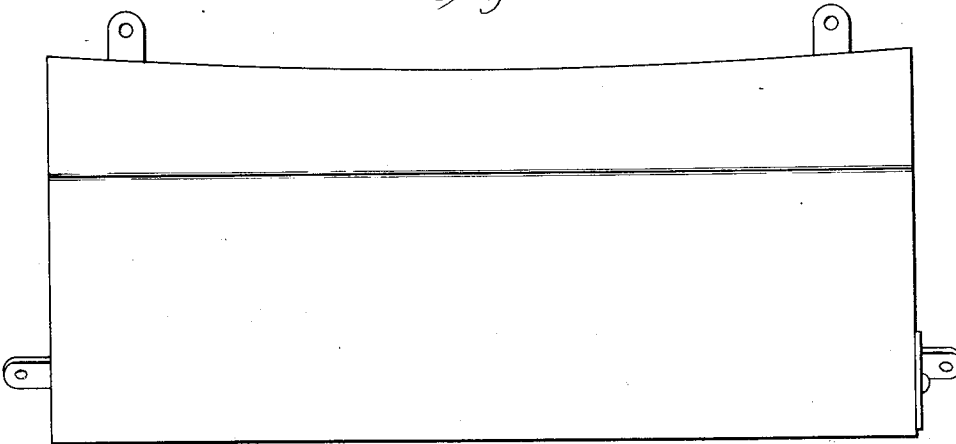

DESIGN FOR AN ILLUMINATED SIGN

To all whom it may concern:
