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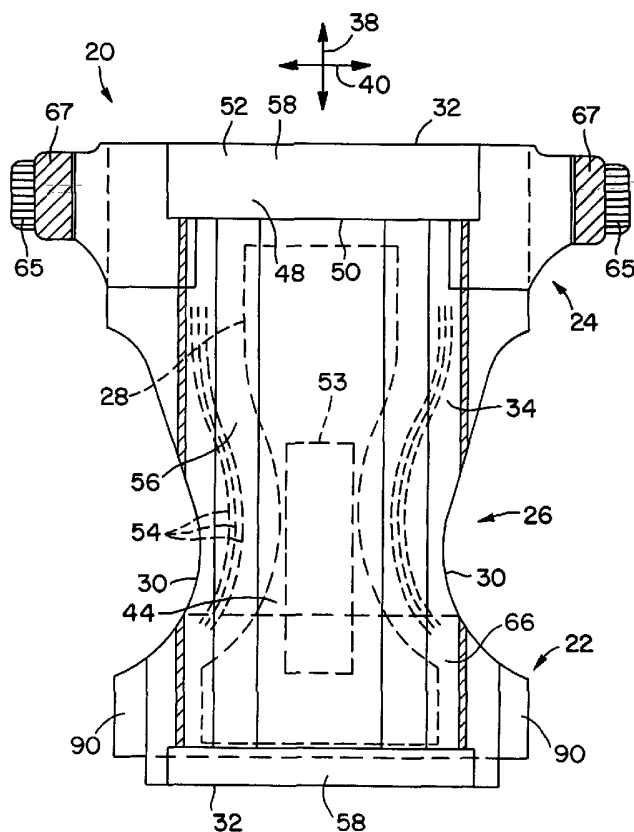

(54) Title: A PRE-FASTENED ABSORBENT ARTICLE HAVING SIMPLIFIED FASTENING FEATURES



(57) Abstract: The invention relates to prefastened absorbent articles (20) including one or more of several improvement features. The articles can be made to be prefastened by having a singular fastening mechanism that includes an oversized fastener (60). The articles of the invention can include a multiple property fastener (60) that has at least one engagement zone (65) and at least one non-abrasive zone (67).
