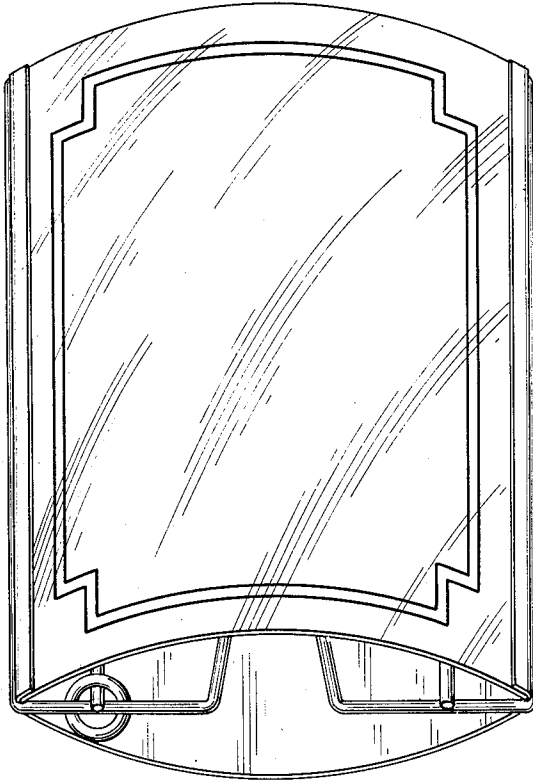

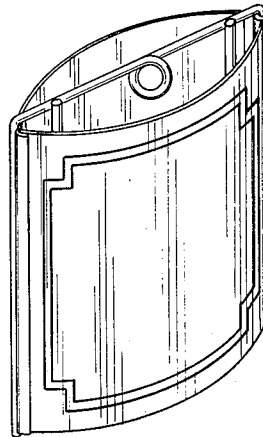

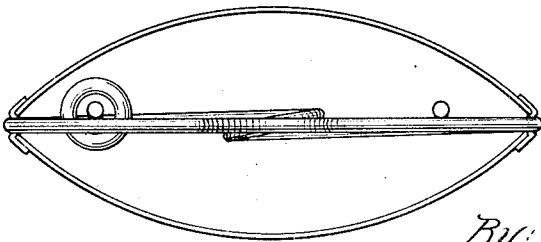

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William F. Vernon, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Newton, in the county of Jasper and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a String Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a string holder, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top perspective view, on a reduced scale.

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view.
