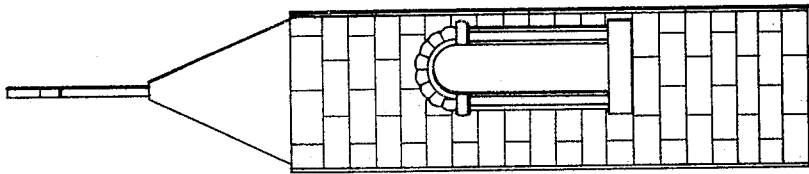

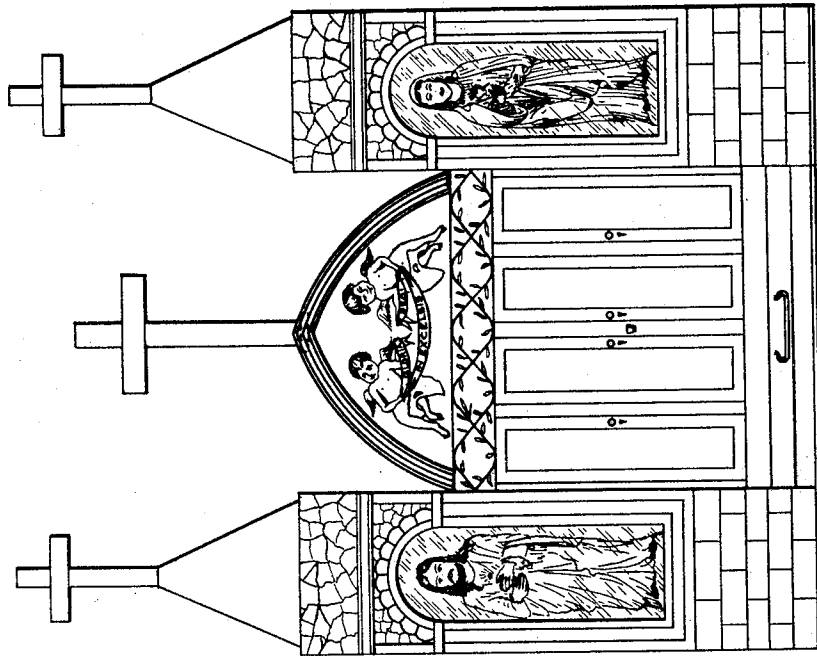

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN D. ARNOLD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Miniature Churches for Home Devotion, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a view of the miniature church in front elevation. Fig. 2 is a view of the church in side elevation.
