



































FIGURE 6 is a side elevation of a second modified embodiment of the handset shown in FIGURE 1;

FIGURE 7 is a back view, as seen from the top in FIGURE 6;

FIGURE 8 is a front perspective view of the second embodiment;

FIGURE 9 is an end view, as seen from the left hand end of FIGURE 6; and

FIGURE 10 is an end view, as seen from the right hand end of FIGURE 6;

FIGURE 11 is a side elevation of a third modified embodiment of the handset shown in FIGURE 1;

FIGURE 12 is a back view, as seen from the top in FIGURE 11;

FIGURE 13 is a front perspective view of the third embodiment;

FIGURE 14 is an end view, as seen from the left hand end of FIGURE 11; and

FIGURE 15 is an end view, as seen from the right hand end of FIGURE 11;

FIGURE 16 is a side view of a fourth embodiment;

FIGURE 17 is a back view, as seen from the top in FIGURE 16;

FIGURE 18 is a front perspective view of a fourth embodiment of the handset shown in FIGURE 1;

FIGURE 19 is an end view, as seen from the left hand end of FIGURE 16; and

FIGURE 20 is an end view, as seen from the right hand end of FIGURE 16.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
