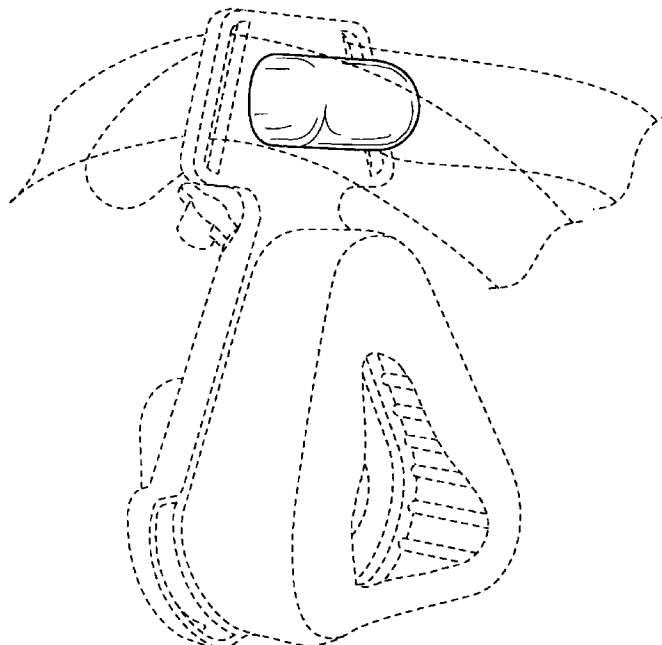
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;

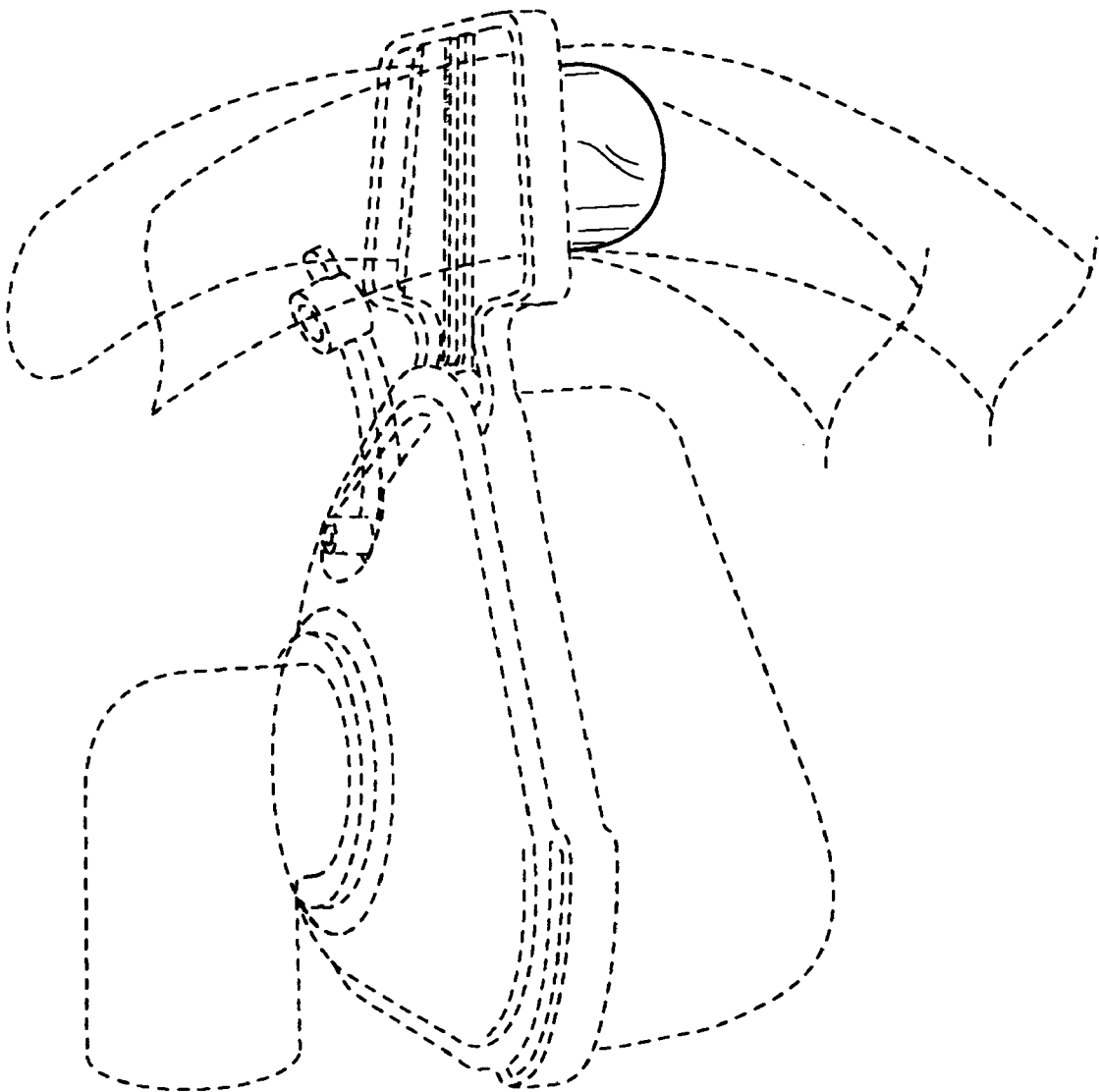

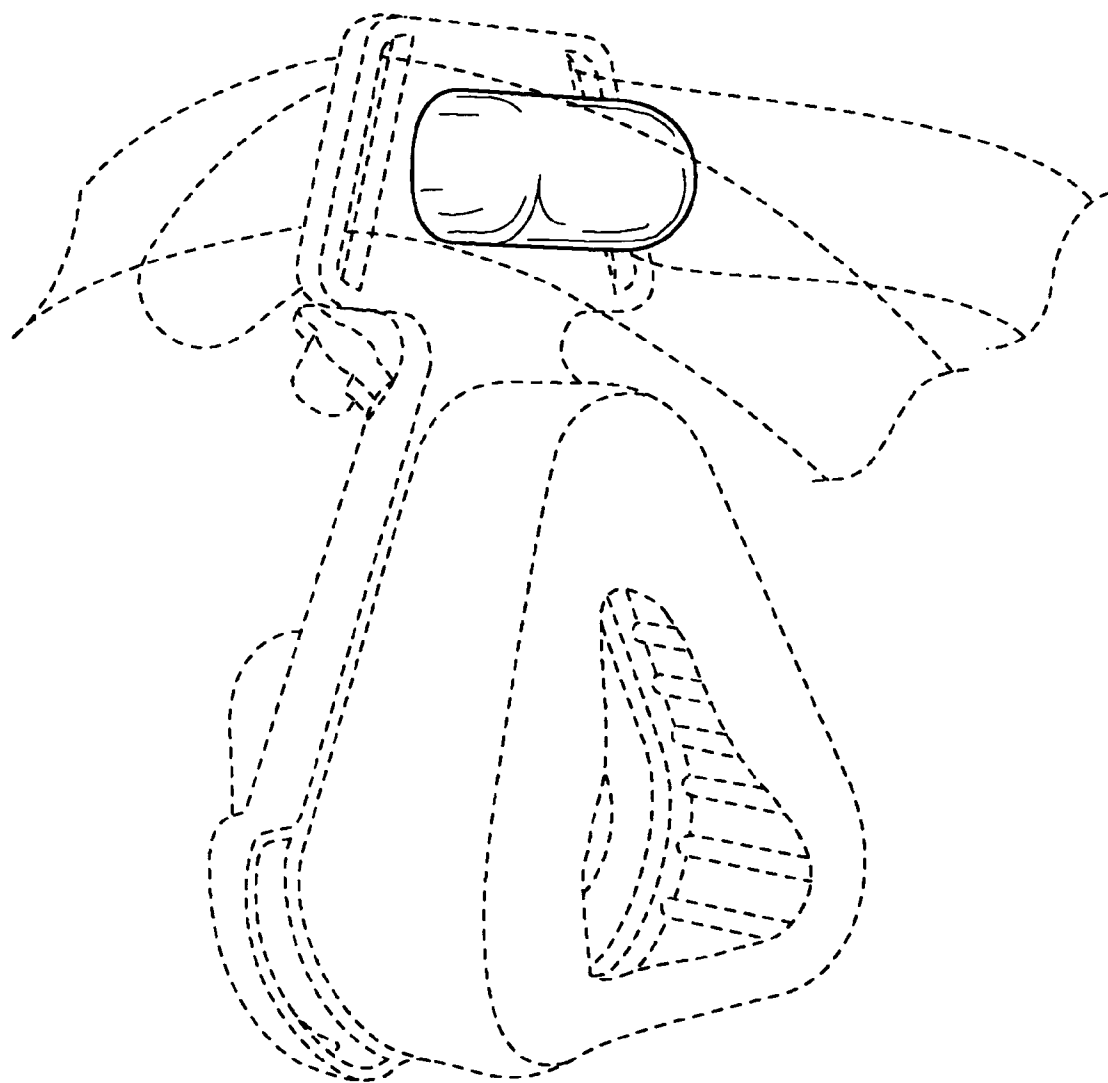

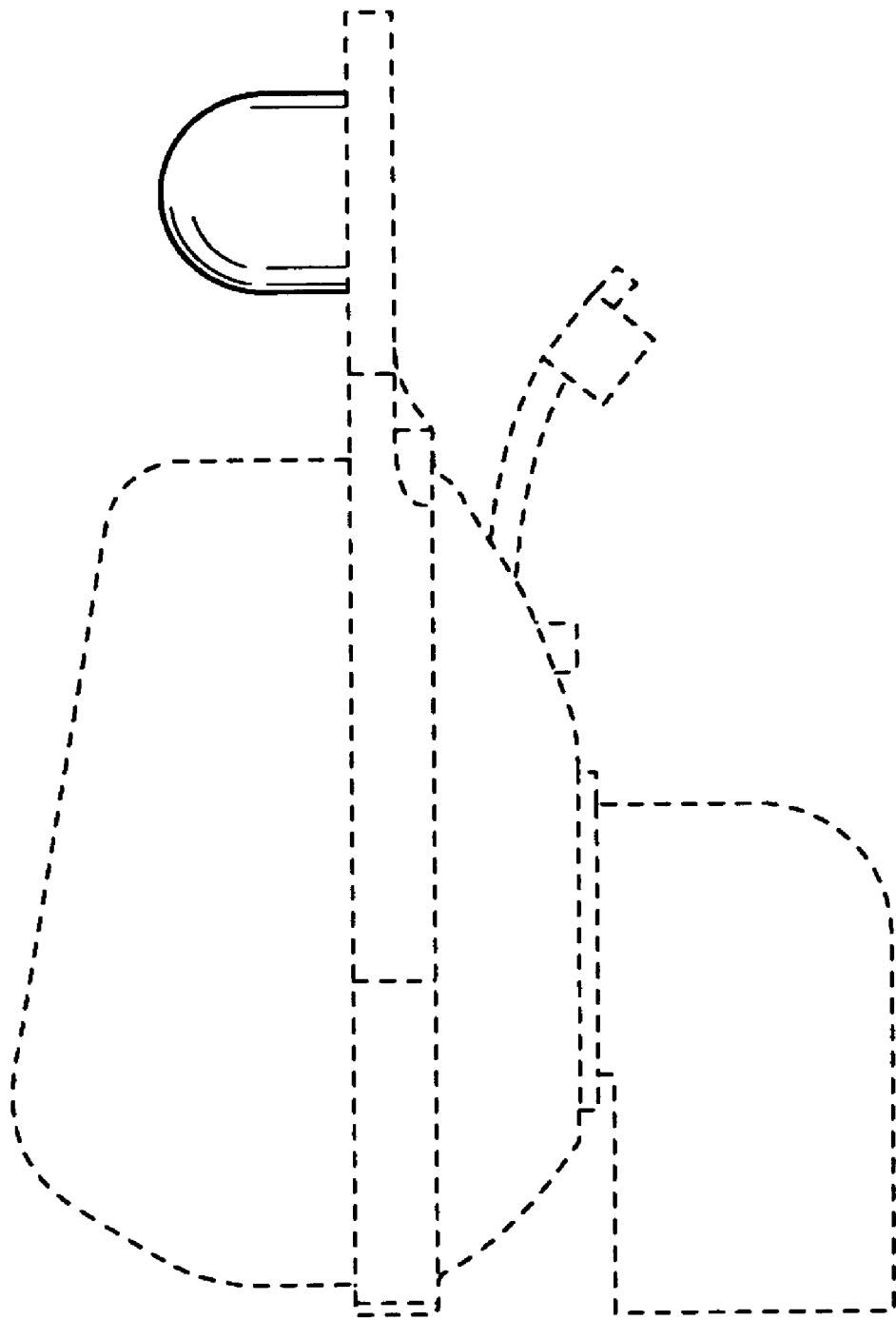

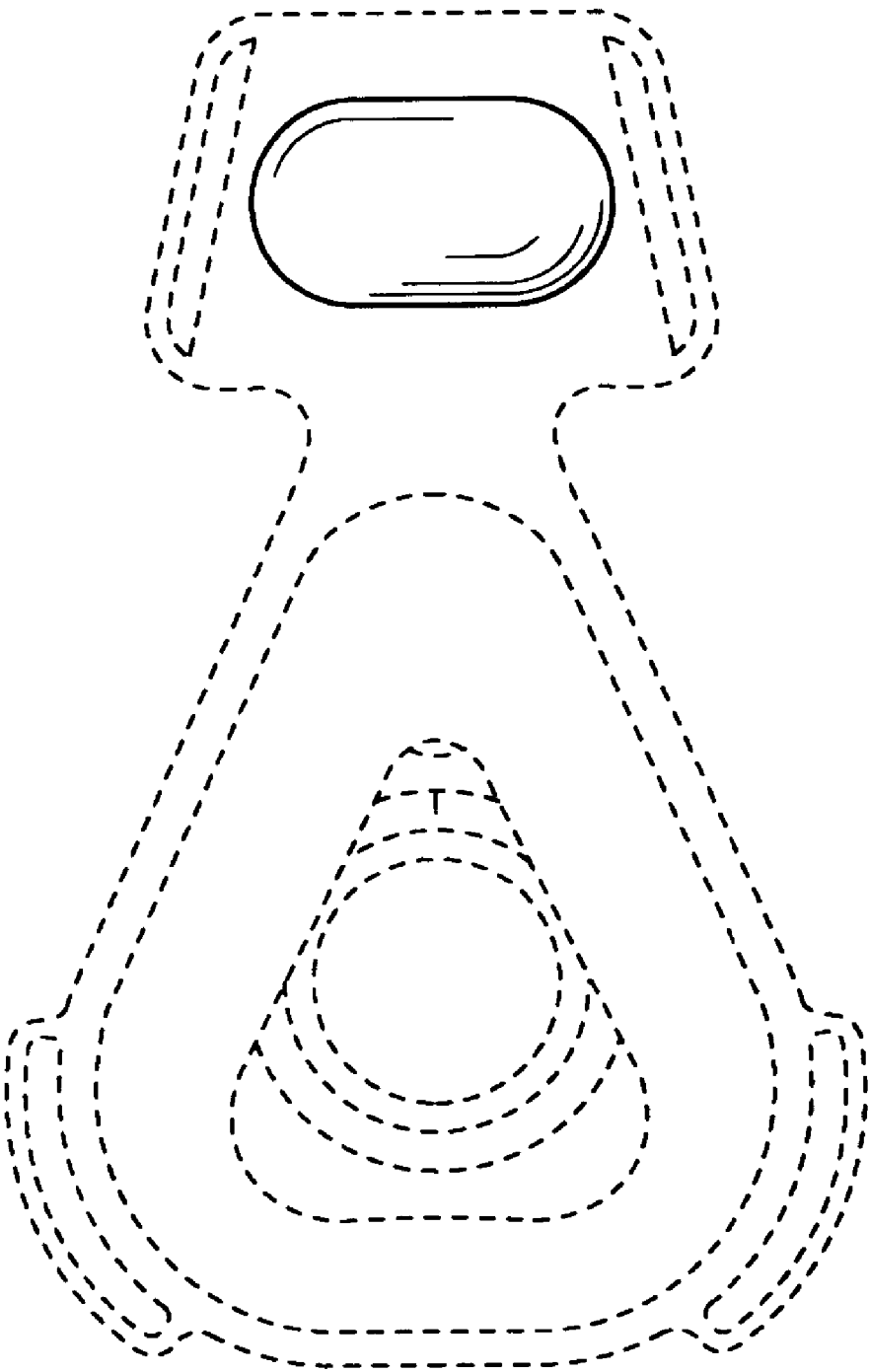

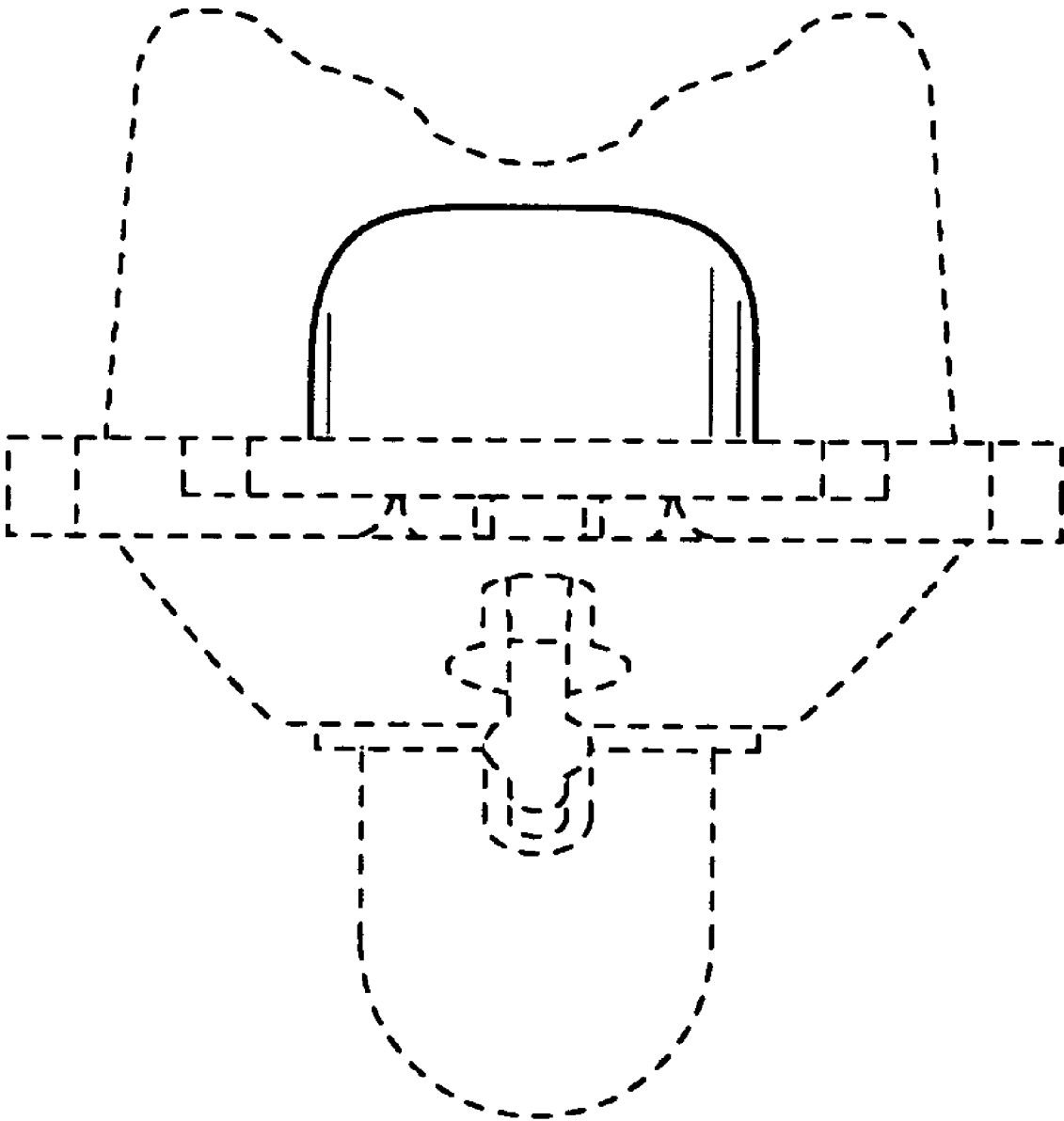
