## DESIGN FOR A PLATE OR DISH.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,337, dated February 14, 1905.

Application filed January 16, 1905. Serial No. 241,379. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILDER A. PICKARD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Plate or Dish, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
