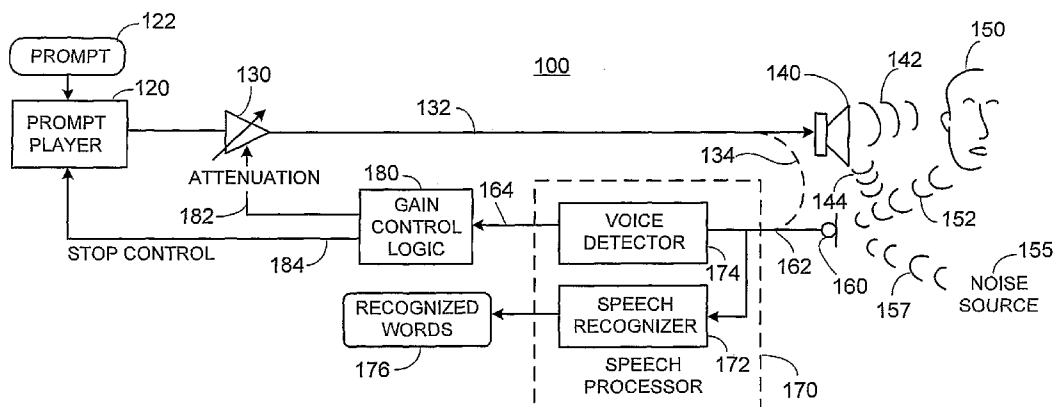

(57) Abstract: When an output is presented to a user, an audio input that can include spoken input from the user is monitored. Presentation of the output is controlled while monitoring the audio input based on the monitoring. In the case of an audio output, the presentation can be controlled by attenuating the audio output according to the monitoring of the audio input.
