The ornamental design for a therapeutic appliance for stress relief, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and top perspective view of the therapeutic appliance for stress relief showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The cord is shown broken in all views to indicate indeterminate length.

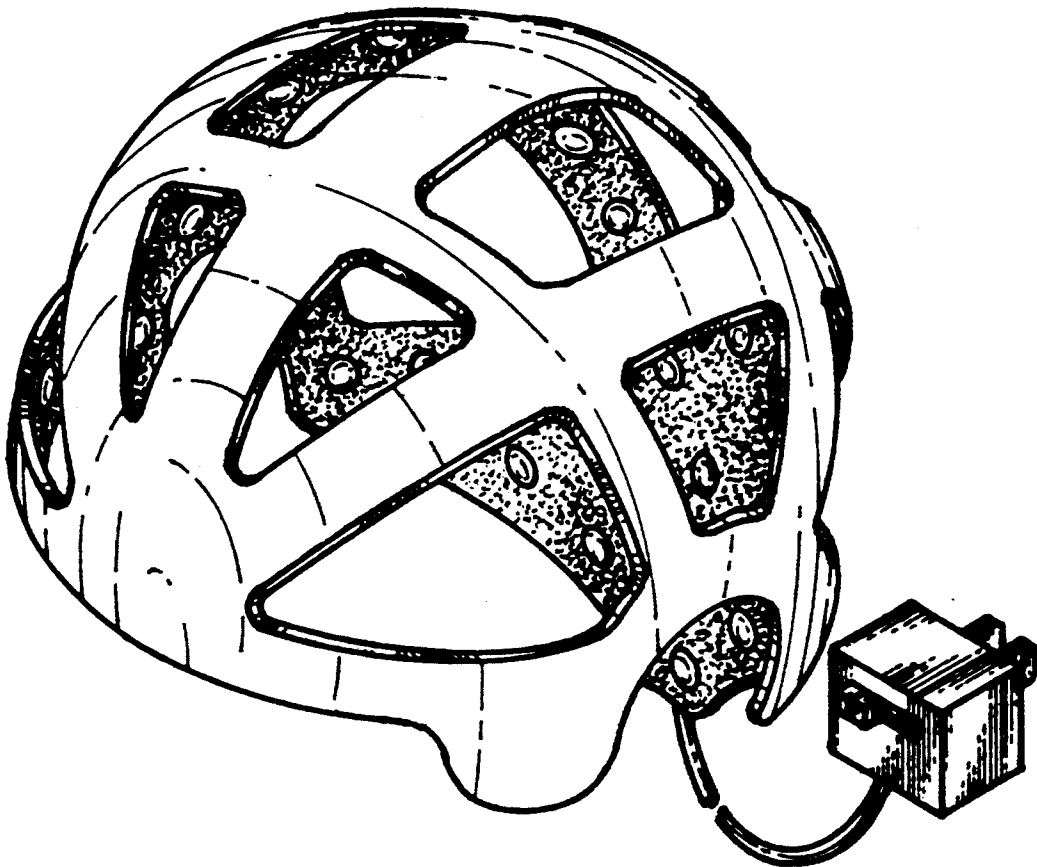

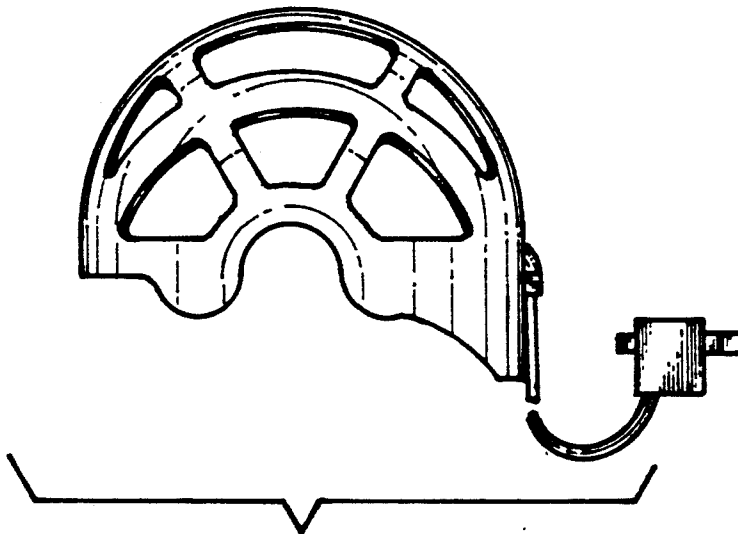

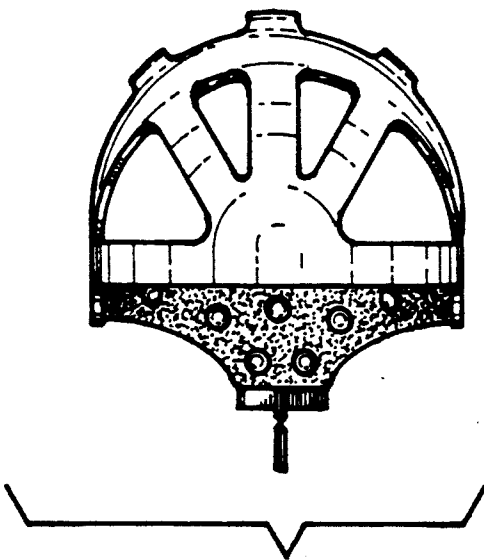

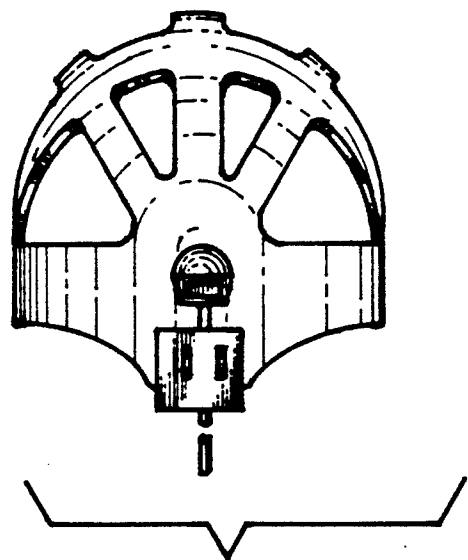

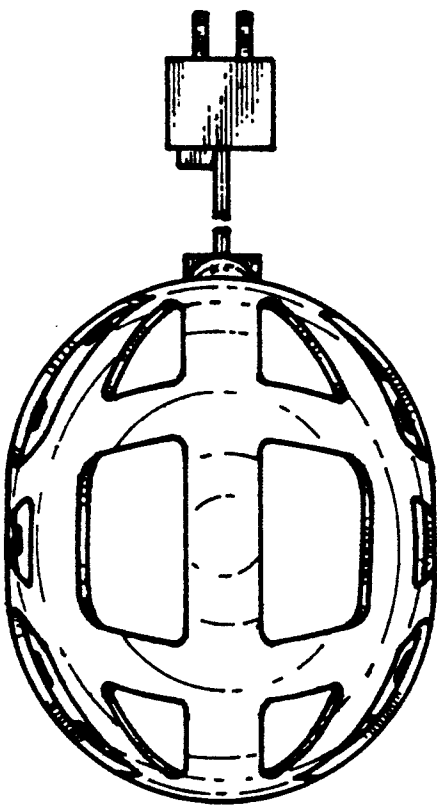
