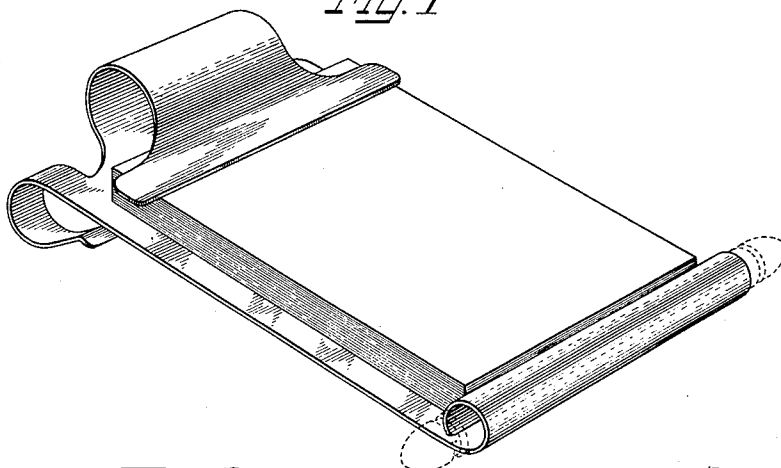

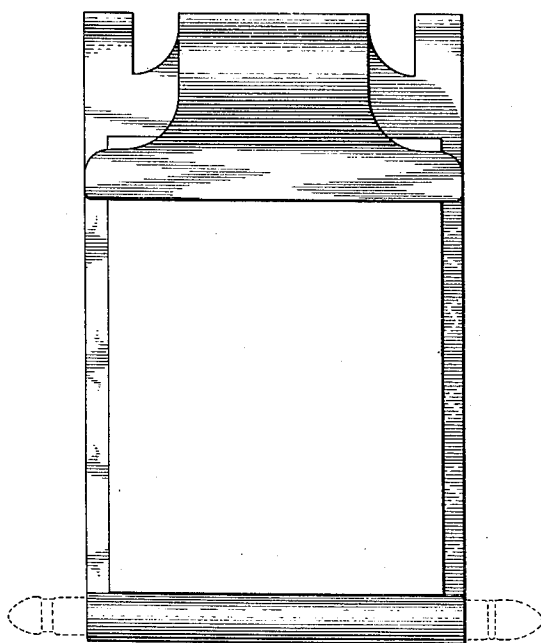

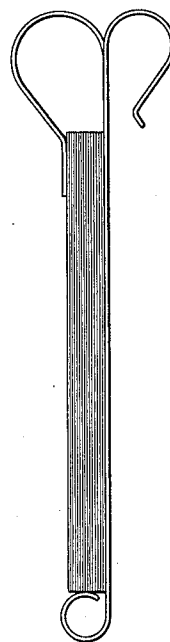

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, George G. Dubinetz and Richard C. Morris, both citizens of the United States, and residents of the city of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have jointly invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Pad and Pencil Holder or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

On the drawing:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a combined pad and pencil holder or similar article, showing our new design;

Figure 2 is a plan view; and

Figure 3 is a side view thereof.

The dominant features of our design reside in those portions shown in full lines.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a combined pad and pencil holder or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
