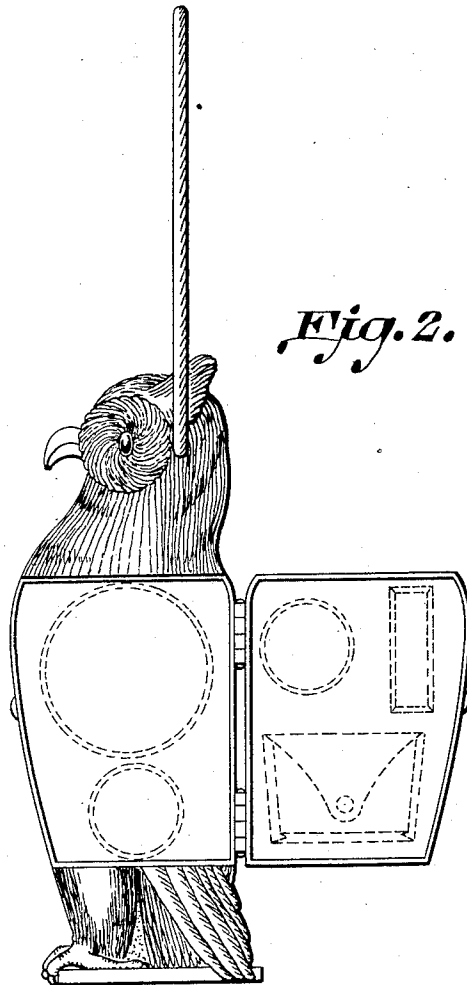

DESIGN FOR A VANITY CASE.

Application filed September 12, 1927. Serial No. 23,389. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM A. HEARD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Jacksonville, in the county of Duval and State of Florida, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vanity Case, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
