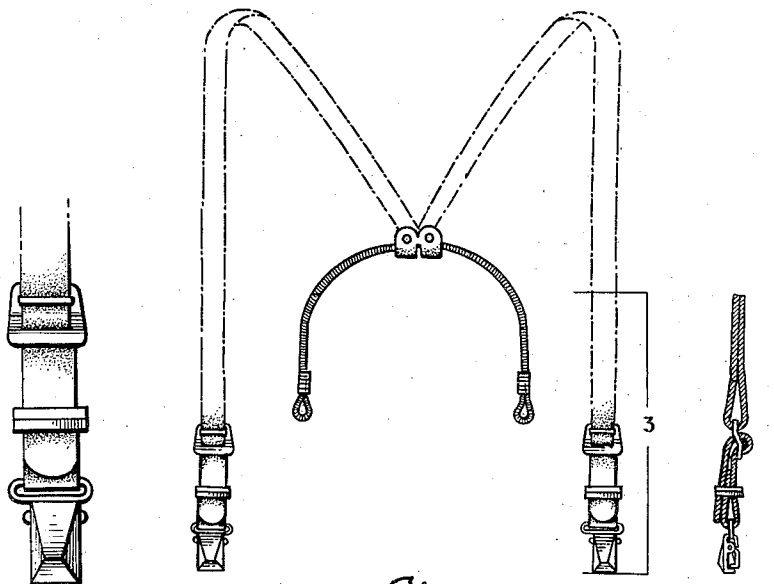

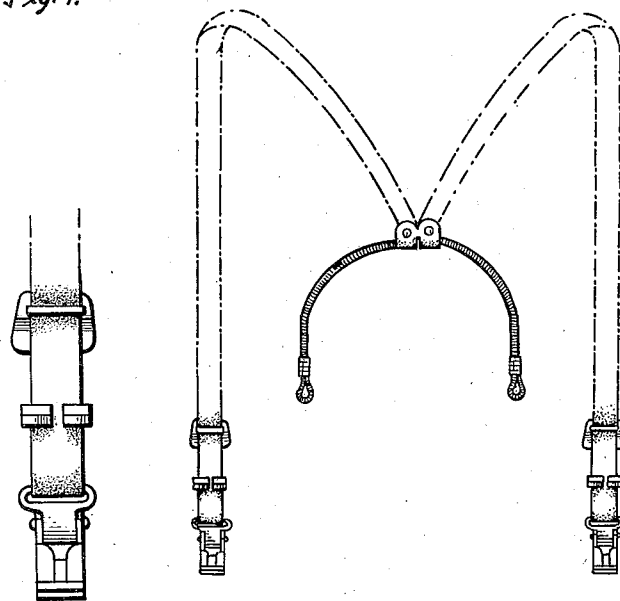

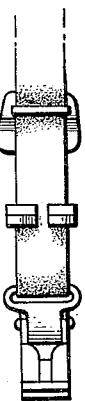

DESIGN FOR A SUSPENDER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John E. Friedman, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Suspender, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a suspender showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a rear view thereof.

Fig. 3 is an edge view taken on 3—3 of Fig. 1.

Figs. 4 and 5 are respectively front and rear fragmentary views on an enlarged scale of the front portions of the suspender shown in full lines in Figs. 1 and 2.

I claim:
