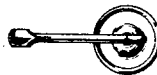
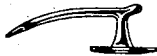

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM M. ISAACS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Collar-Buttons, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part hereof, wherein—
