



*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Joseph F. Meyer, a citizen of the United States, residing in St. Paul, county of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Paper Napkin or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of one quarter portion of a paper napkin showing my new design, the other three quarter portions being duplicates of that shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a paper napkin or the like, substantially as shown and described.
