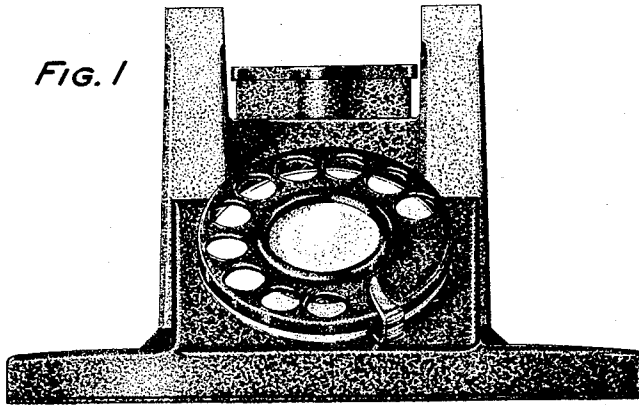

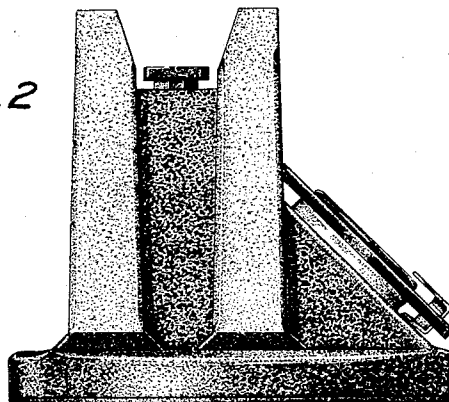
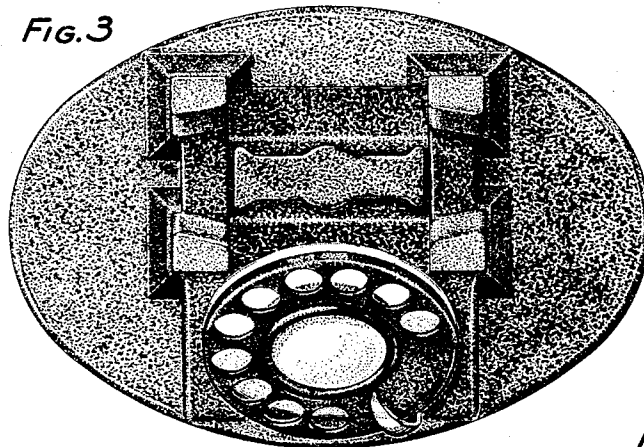

DESIGN FOR A DESK STAND FOR A HAND TELEPHONE

To all whom it may concern:
