

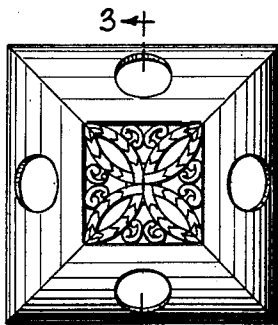

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Robert Appel, a citizen of the United States, and residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Plaque Unit for Articulated Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a plaque unit for articu-

lated fabric or similar article, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a transverse sectional view taken on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.
