

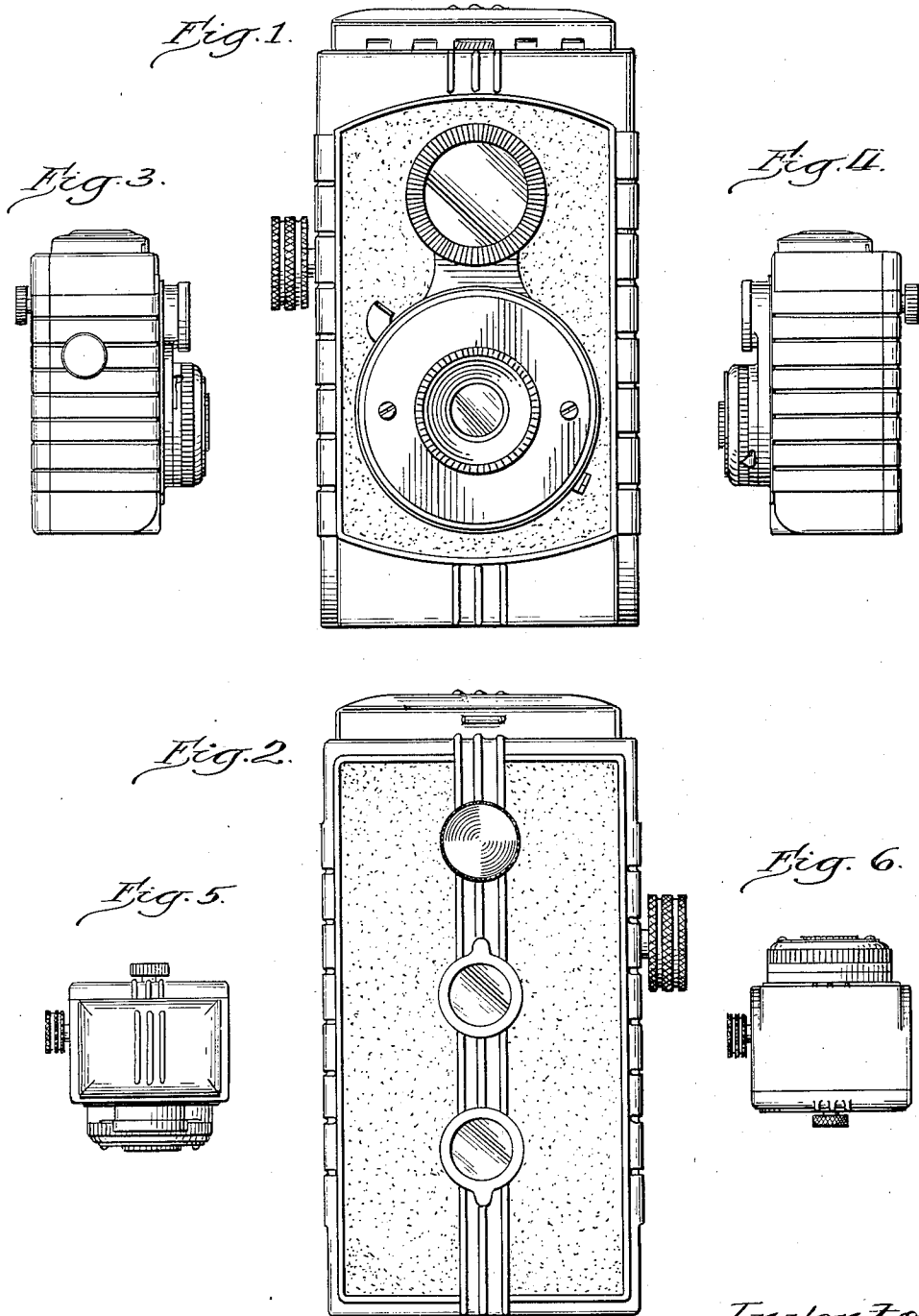

DESIGN FOR A CAMERA

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max Bressler, a citizen of the United States and resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Camera, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a camera showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a rear elevational view of the same.

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of the same.

Fig. 4 is an elevational view of the opposite side.

Fig. 5 is a top plan view of the same.

Fig. 6 is a bottom plan view of the same.

Figs. 3 to 6 are on reduced scales in comparison with the disclosures in Figs. 1 and 2.
