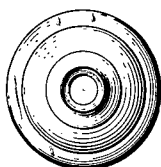

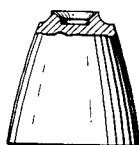
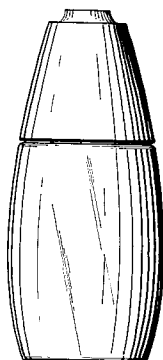

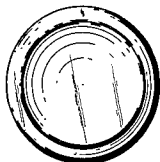


FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a condiment shaker, showing our new design characterized by a convexly curved container body and a cover portion having a relatively flat section, the center of which comprises a shallow conical-shaped cavity;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the cover portion partly in section, of the condiment shaker.
