FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a portion of a sheet of apertured coverstock for absorbent articles showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on plane 2—2 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on plane 3—3 in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1 and 4 indicate that the claimed design continues indefinitely in one or more directions.

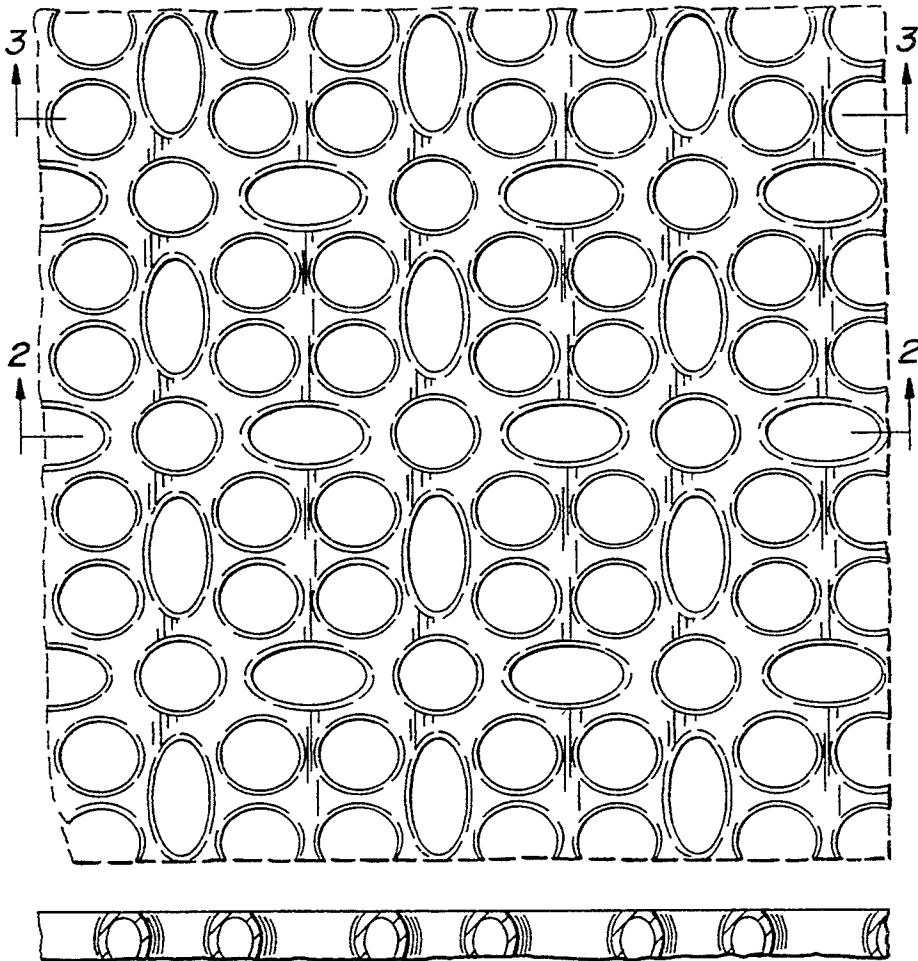

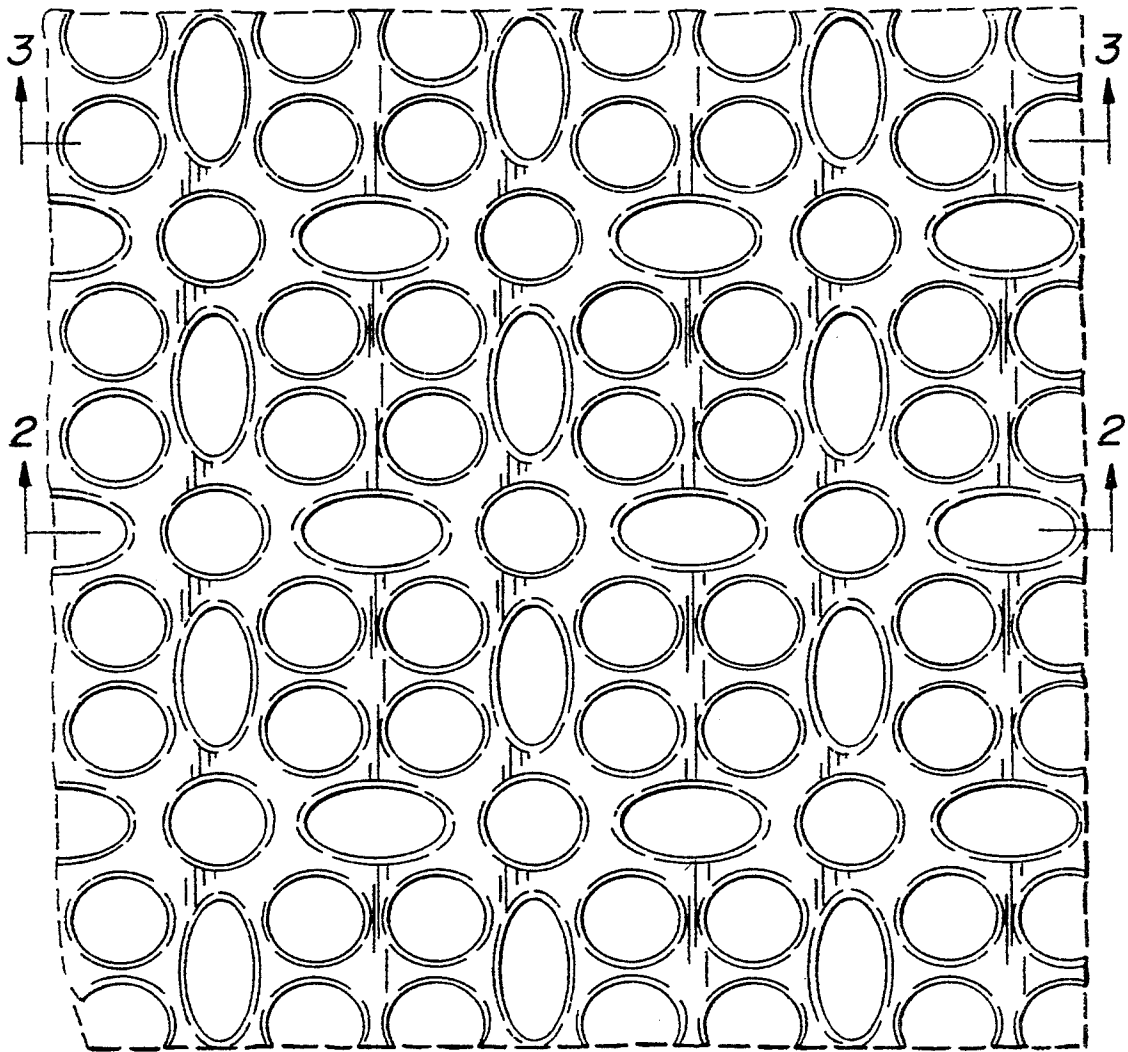
