

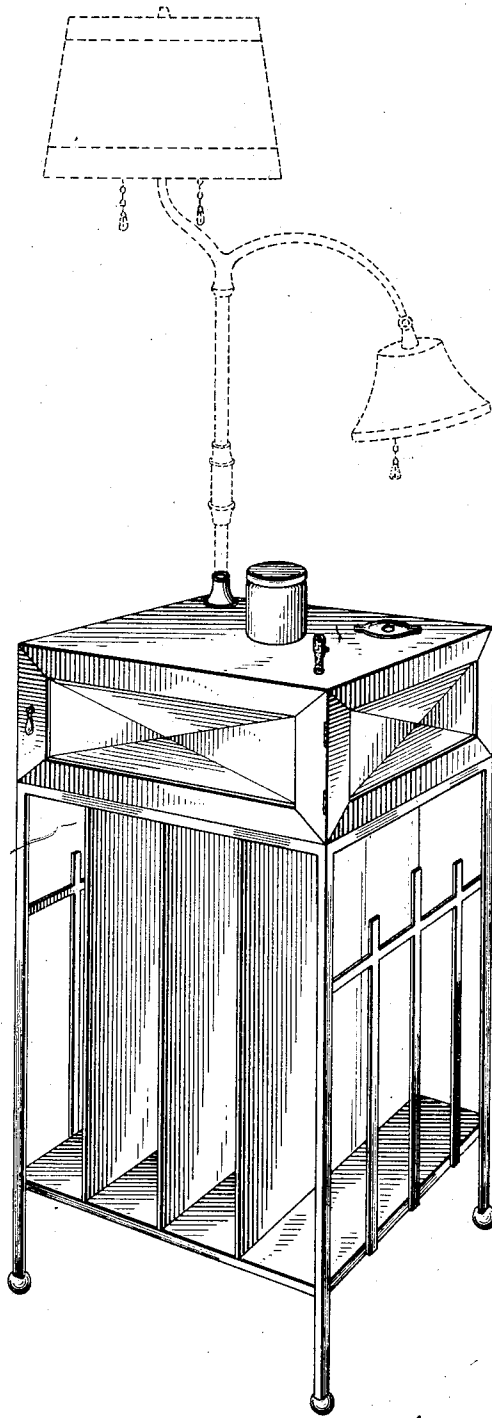

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED SMOKER'S AND READER'S STAND

Application filed December 7, 1929. Serial No. 33,684. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOACHIM B.
