DESIGN FOR A FINGER RING OR ARTICLE OF SIMILAR NATURE

Application filed February 10, 1930. Serial No. 34,475. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BENJAMIN GROSS, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Finger Ring or Article of Similar Nature, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
