

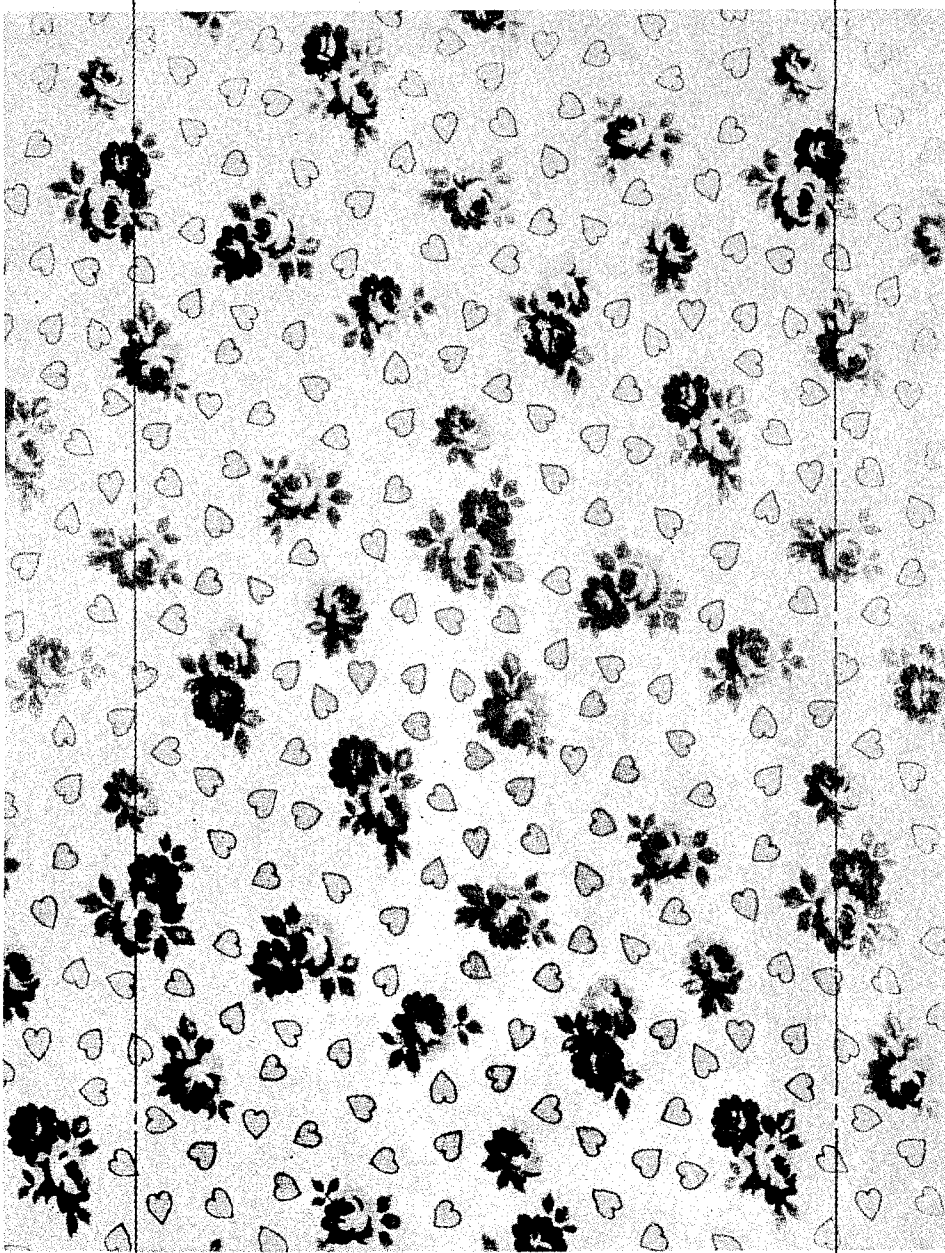

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Ethel S. Kales, a citizen of the United States, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Printed Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a piece of printed

fabric showing my new design. The broken lines outline a design unit, which unit is repeated in regular succession throughout the length of the fabric as indicated.
