The ornamental design for a medallion holder, as shown and described.


**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the medallion holder according to the present invention;  
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the medallion holder of FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image.  
 FIG. 3 is a top view of the medallion holder of FIG. 1.  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the medallion holder of FIG. 1.  
 FIG. 5 is a right side view of the medallion holder of FIG. 1.  
 FIG. 6 is a left side view of the medallion holder of FIG. 1; and,  
 FIG. 7 is a top perspective view of a medallion holder of FIG. 1 illustrating the individual medallion sleeves in various rotated positions.  
 The portions of the design shown in dashed lines do not form a part of the claimed invention.  
 The break lines shown in FIGS. 1 through 7 are not part of the claimed design and represent that no particular length is claimed.










