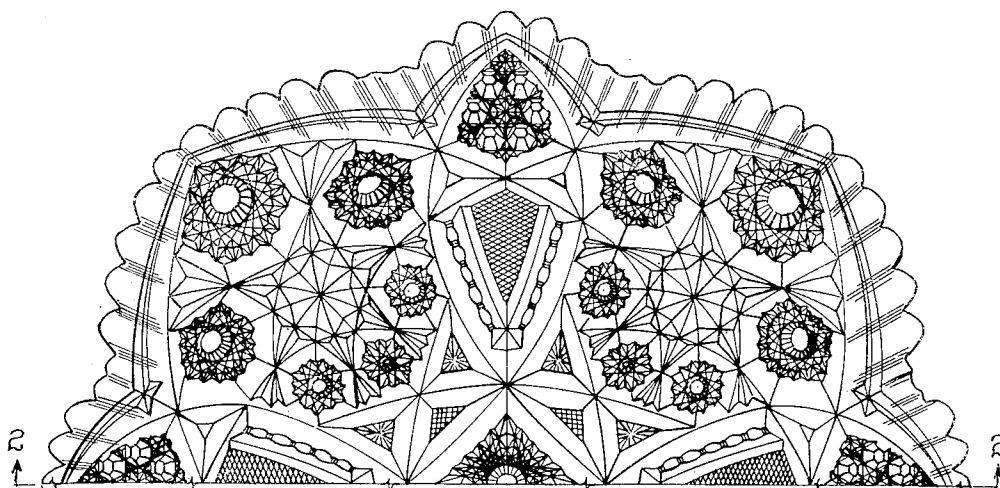

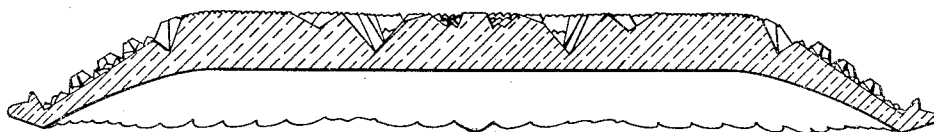

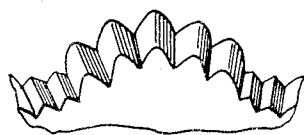

DESIGN FOR A GLASS DISH

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Maurice A. Smith, a citizen of the United States, residing at Jeannette, in the county of Westmoreland and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Glass Dish, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a bottom plan view of a glass dish, half of which is in outline, showing my design;

Fig. 2 a cross-sectional view thereof taken along the line 2—2, Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 an enlarged detail of the edge of the dish.
