

The ornamental design for a toy printing member, sub-  
stantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy printing  
member showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left  
side being substantially a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.










