[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a side frame for an arm chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view, looking slightly from above of a side frame for an arm chair in accordance with one embodiment showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 7 is a front perspective view, looking slightly from above of a side frame for an arm chair in accordance with another embodiment showing my new design; FIG. 8 is a front elevational view; FIG. 9 is a top plan view; FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 13 is a front perspective view, looking slightly from above of a side frame for an arm chair in accordance with another embodiment showing my new design; FIG. 14 is a front elevational view; FIG. 15 is a top plan view; FIG. 16 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 17 is a rear elevational view; and, FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view.

The broken lines illustrated in the drawings are not part of the claimed design.




































