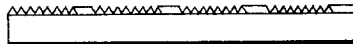

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EDWARD J. WALSH, a citizen of the United States, residing at St. Louis, Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Sheet-Glass, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
