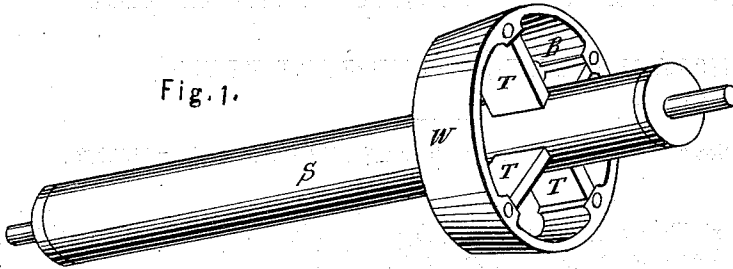

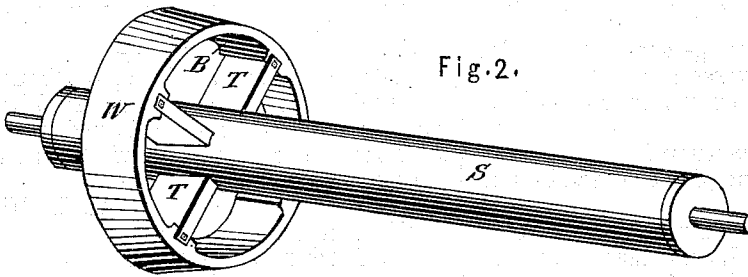

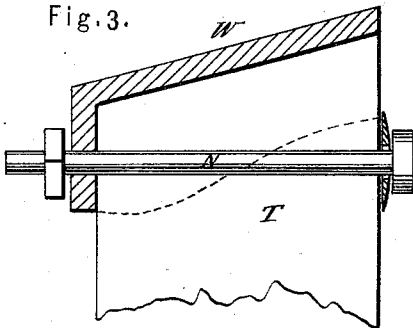
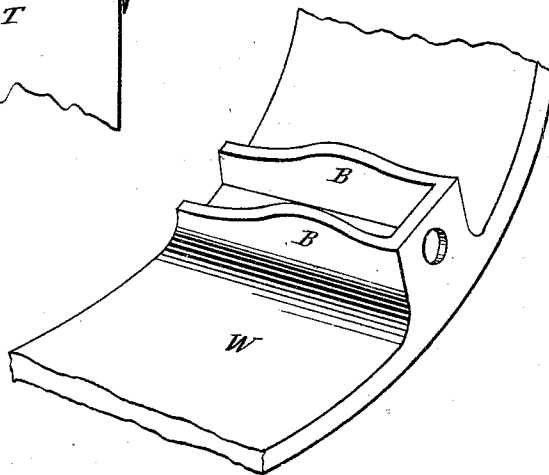

IMPROVEMENT IN SAND-PUMP REELS.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 127,058, dated May 21, 1872.

I, HOSEA T. HUNT, of Titusville, Crawford county, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and Improved Sand-Pump Reel for Artesian Wells, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, in which—

Figures 1 and 2 are general perspective views; Fig. 3, a transverse section; and Fig. 4 an enlarged view of portion of rim, showing shoulder and sockets.

The object of my invention is the construction of an efficient and durable sand-pump reel.

For this purpose I have upon the ordinary shaft S a beveled wheel, composed of an iron rim, W, cast with the shoulder and sockets B

B, into which are fitted spokes T T, secured by the bolt N.

The rim W and spoke T being on a bevel, if they become in any way loosened, they are securely and easily drawn together by means of the bolt N.

I claim as my invention—

The construction of the spoke T in connection with the beveled metallic rim W, with its shoulders and sockets B B, and the bolt N, all arranged in the manner shown, and for the purposes above set forth.
