**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a setting for a ring showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the setting for a ring.

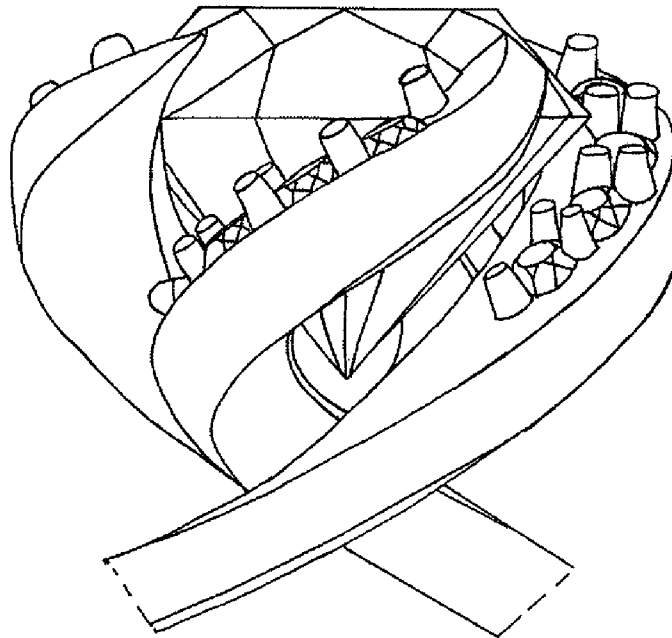
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the setting for a ring in which the left side elevational view is a mirror image of the right side shown.

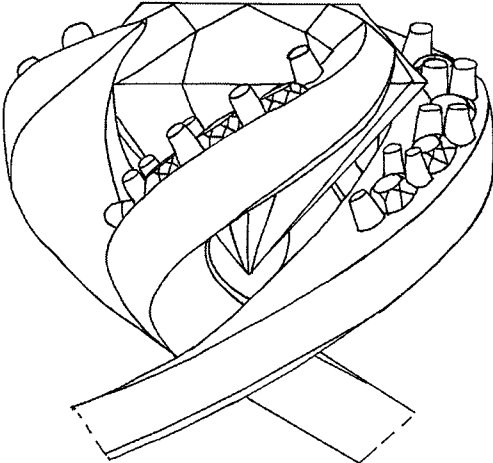

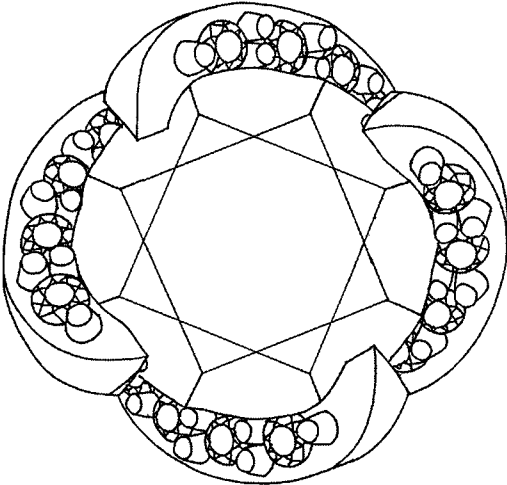

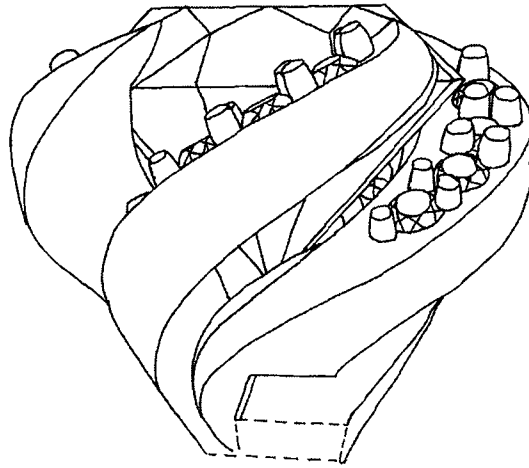

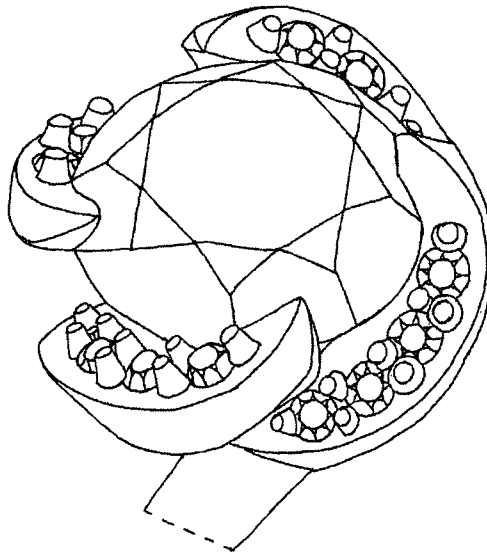

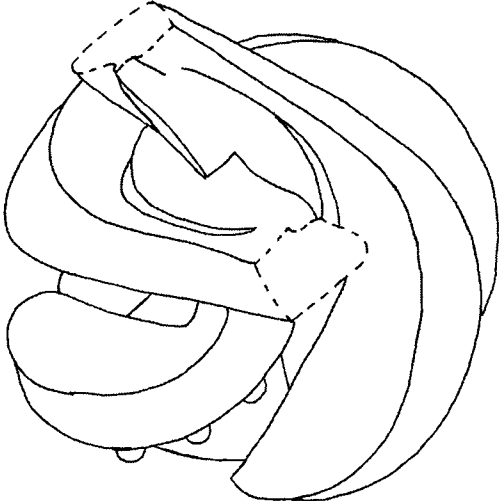
