





To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Raleigh E. Tresise and Paul D. Kendall, citizens of the United States, residing at Cleveland Heights and Maple Heights, respectively, in the county of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Battery Box or Similar Container, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein Fig. 1 is an elevational view of the front or back of

the box or similar container showing new design, the front and back being identical; Fig. 2 is an elevational view of one end of said box or container and Fig. 3 is an elevational view of the opposite end of the said box or container.
