DESCRIPTION

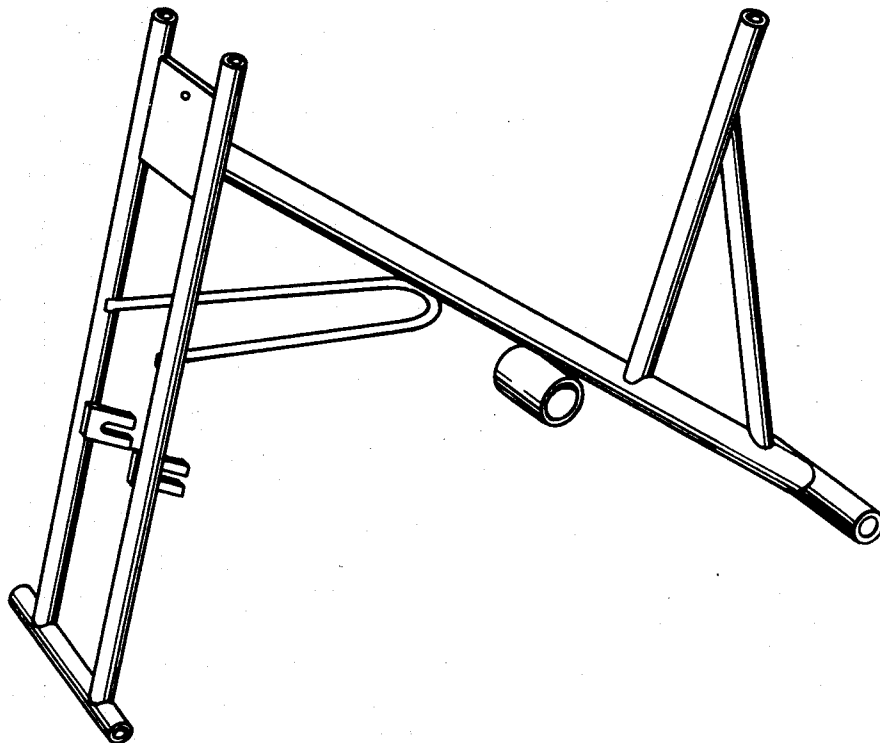
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a frame for exerciser showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



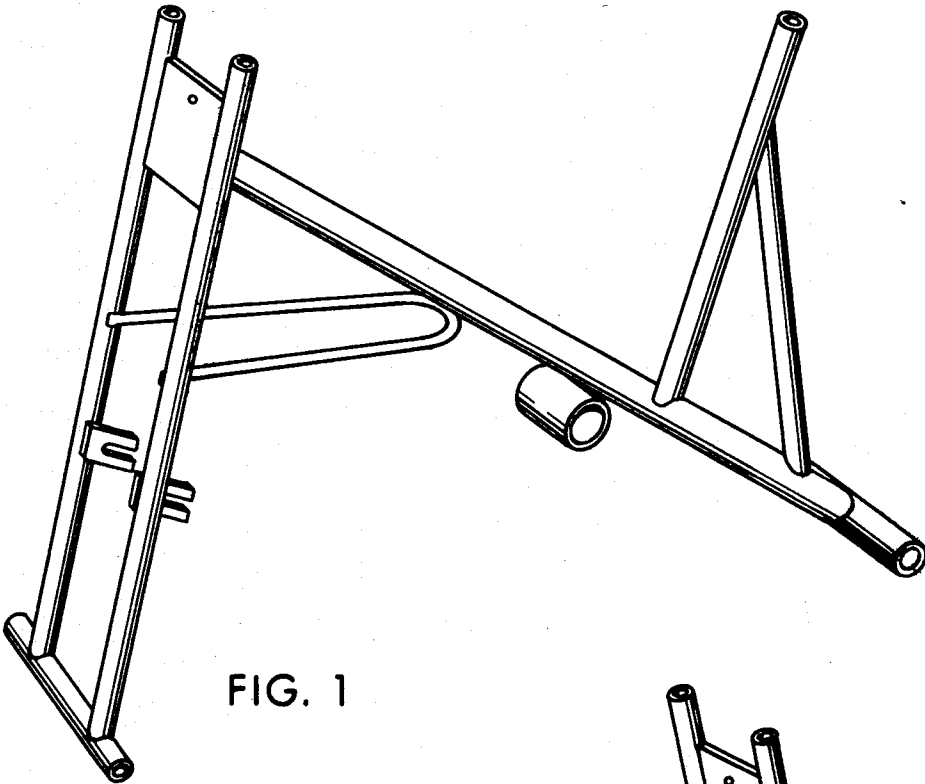

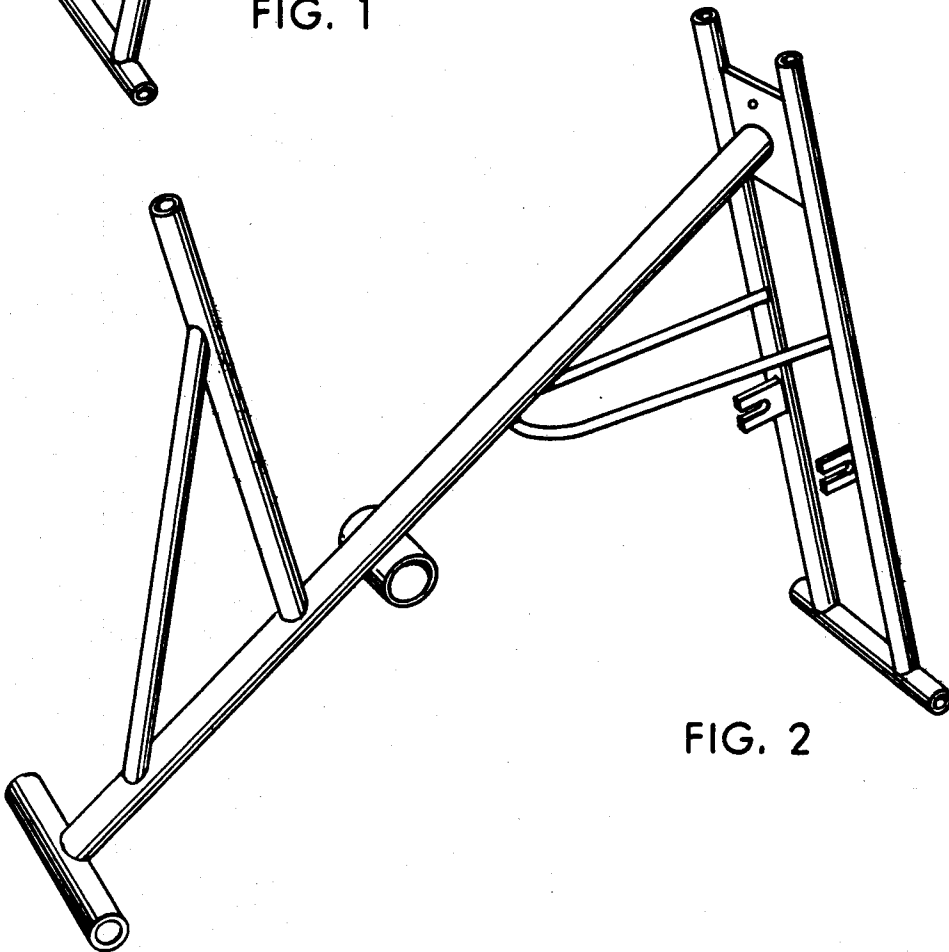

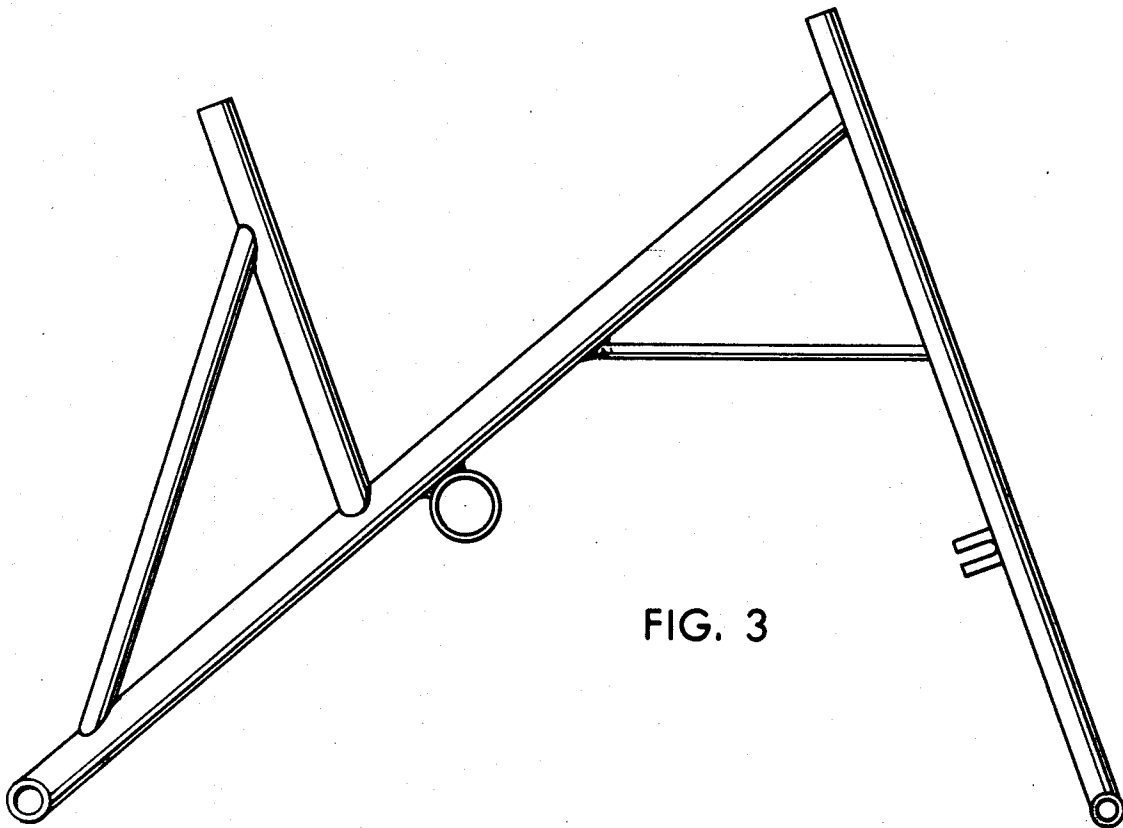

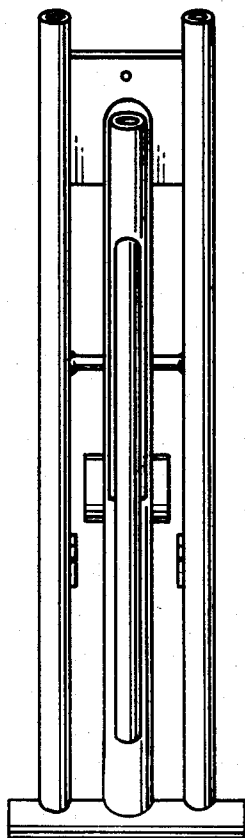

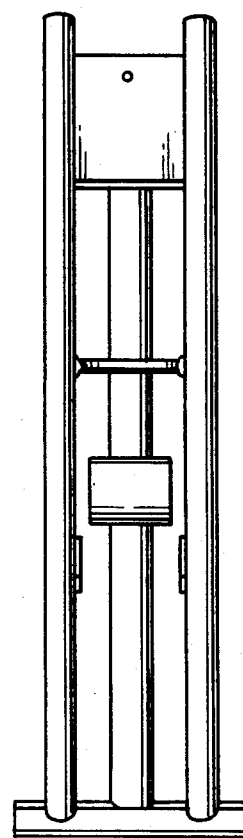
