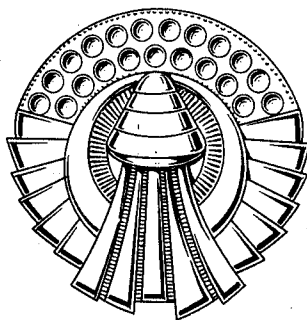

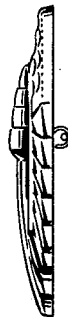

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Cooper, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pin or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
