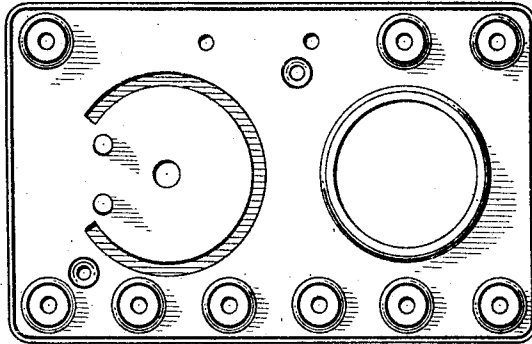

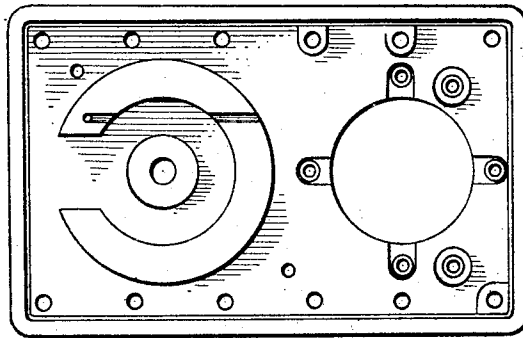
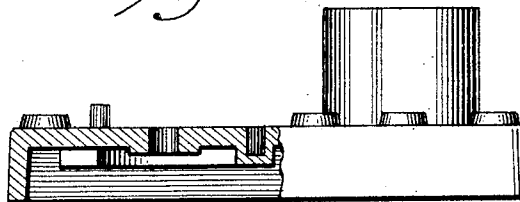

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED P. MORGAN, a citizen of the United States, residing in the town of Montclair, county of Essex, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Instrument-Mount for Radiopanel, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective plan view of the top of the instrument mount; Fig. 2 is a like view of the bottom, and Fig. 3 is a view in elevation, part being broken away to show a detail of the design.
