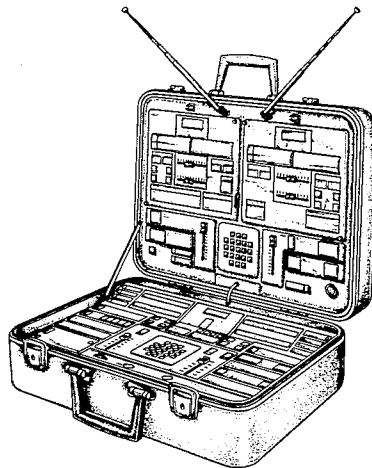
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portable self-contained surveillance and detection device, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view, in an open position, of a portable self-contained surveillance and detection device showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a front perspective view in a closed position thereof.

The opposite sides not shown are substantially the same as those shown.



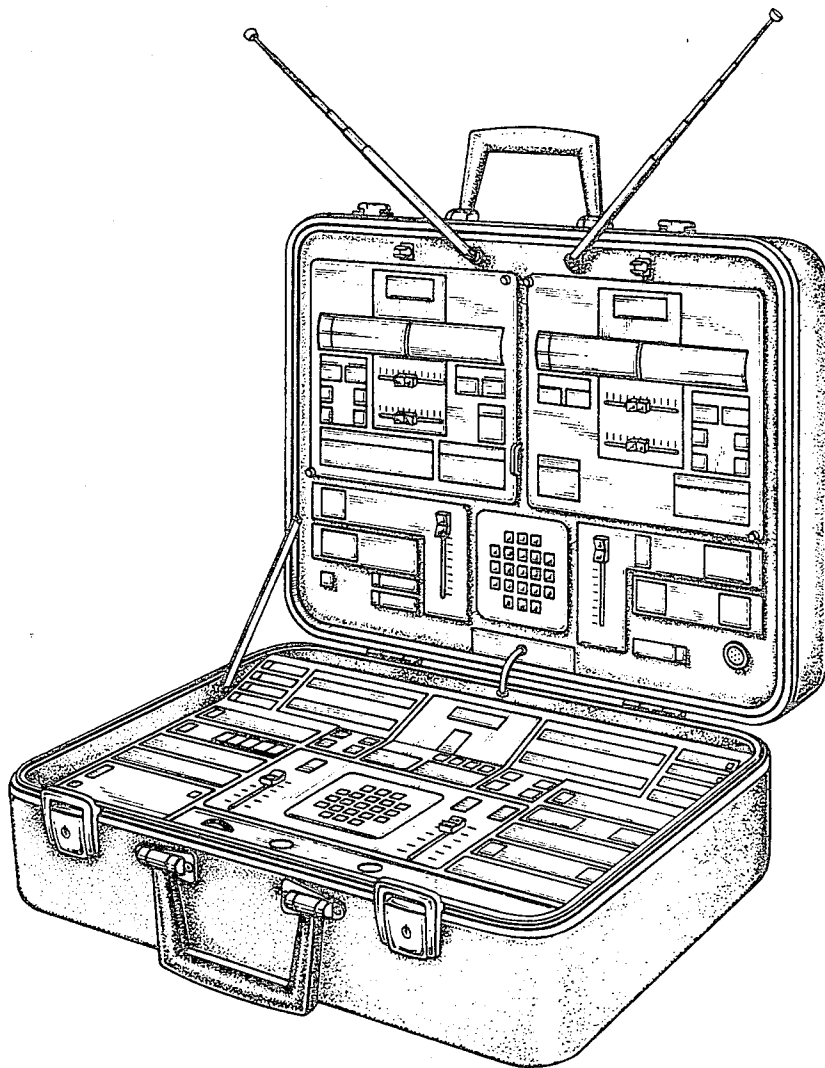

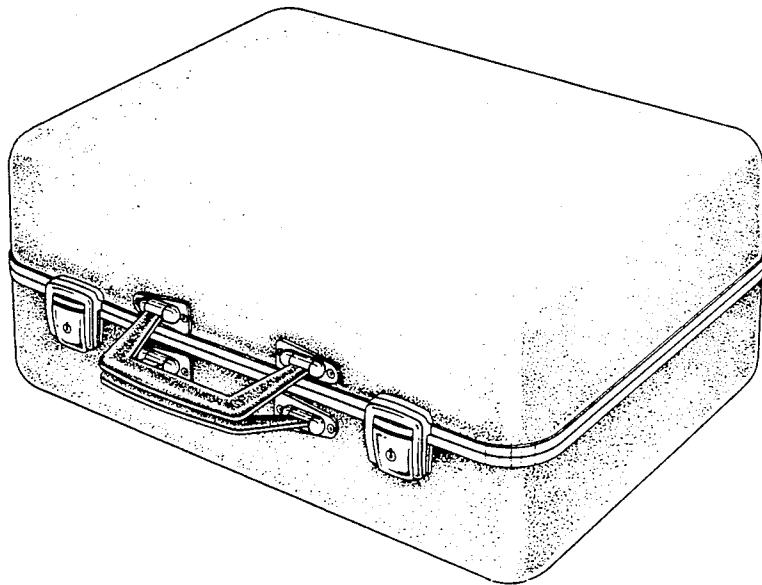
