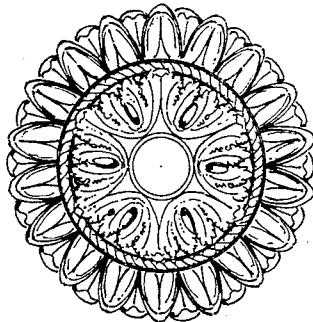

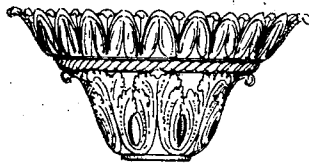

DESIGN FOR A PLATE FOR LIGHTING FIXTURES.

To all whom it may concern:
