

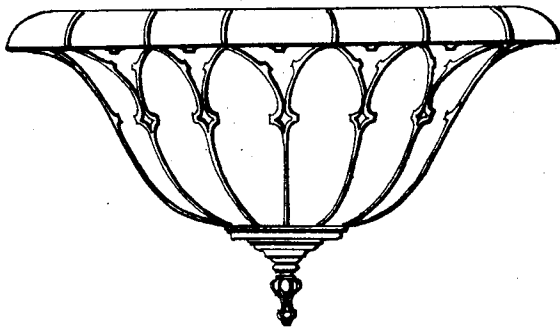

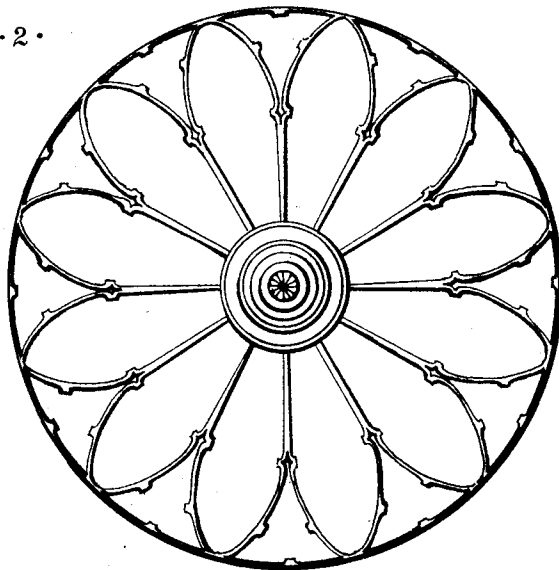

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE W. BAYLEY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric-Lighting Fixture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of an electric lighting fixture, showing my new design. Fig. 2 is a bottom view of the same.
