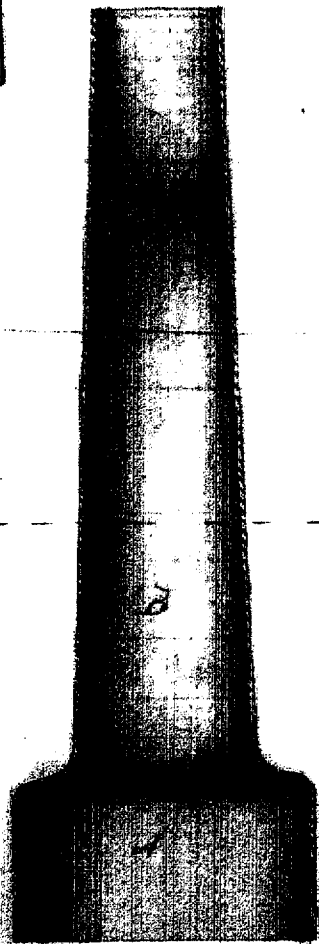
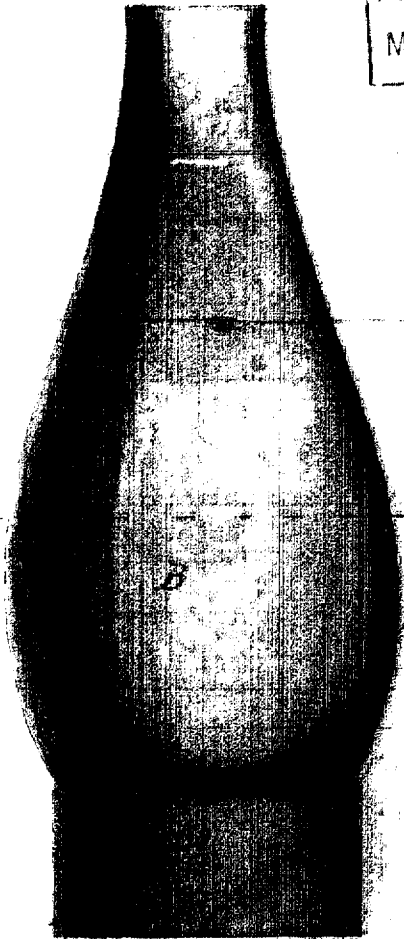

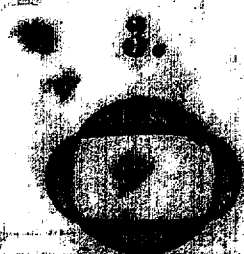

DESIGN FOR A LAMP-CHIMNEY.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT HEMINGRAY, of Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have produced a new Design for a Lamp-Chimney; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and letters of reference marked thereon, forming part of this description.

Figure 1 is an elevation representing the outline of the chimney from one point of view.

Figure 2 is a sectional elevation, representing an outline from a point of view at right angles with that represented in fig. 1.

Figure 3 is a transverse section upon the plane indicated by dotted lines 1 and 2.

The chimney is composed wholly of glass, and is entirely plain, without ornamental figures, and without abrupt angles. The base, A, is cylindrical, and about one-sixth of the entire length of the chimney.

The body of the chimney, B, is of an oval form, being enlarged gradually from the base, to form one diameter greater than the diameter of the base, as represented in fig. 1, and being contracted suddenly to another diameter less than the diameter of the base, as represented in fig. 2, and forming at the dotted line 1-2 the oval outline, represented in fig. 3. The larger diameter is contracted gradually from about the centre of the chimney upward, and at the top the oval outline merges into and becomes circular.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a lamp-chimney, herein represented and described.
