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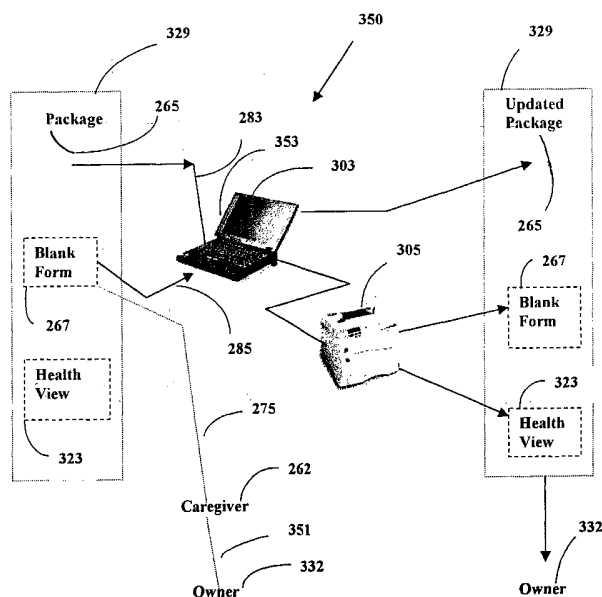
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(54) Title: PORTABLE PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION PACKAGE



(57) Abstract: A health information package (329) that a person carries with him at all times with all his health data, and enables him to grant caregivers (262) instant access to all or any part of his health data, whenever the information is needed, at all points of care anywhere in the world, in computer readable and eye readable forms (285). A blank data recording form and an updated health overview, organized by body organ systems, problems, types and sub-types of data can be printed when desired (329). With the package (329), any standard personal computer (303) can be used to record, update, link, integrate, and display health data from birth to death.


