#### (57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a motorized skin care device, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motorized skin care device showing our new design

FIG. 2 is top plan view of FIG. 1,

FIG. 3 is bottom plan view of FIG. 1,

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of FIG. 1, which is a mirror image of the alternate side elevation view,

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1, and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the motorized skin care device wherein the portion shown in broken lines forms no part of this embodiment;

FIG. 8 is top plan view of FIG. 7,

FIG. 9 is bottom plan view of FIG. 7,

FIG. 10 is a side elevation view of FIG. 7, which is a mirror image of the alternate side elevation view,

FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of FIG. 7, and

FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 13 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the motorized skin care device wherein the stippling represents a contrast in color;

FIG. 14 is top plan view of FIG. 13,

FIG. 15 is bottom plan view of FIG. 13,

FIG. 16 is a side elevation view of FIG. 13, which is a mirror image of the alternate side elevation view,

FIG. 17 is a front elevation view of FIG. 13; and,

FIG. 18 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 13.




















