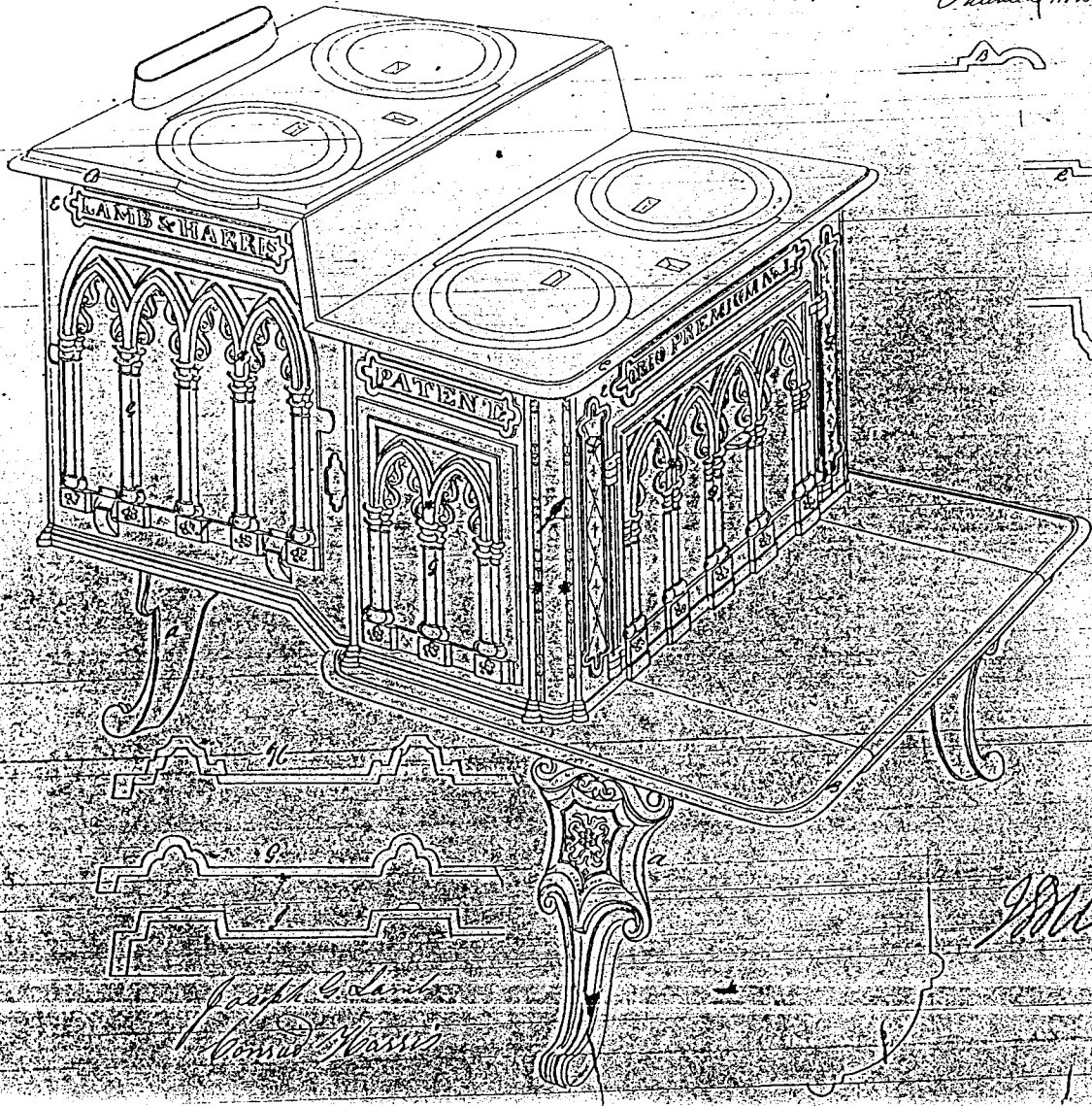

To whom it may Concern:

Be it known that we, Joseph G Lamb  
and Conrad Harris of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, State of Ohio,  
have invented or produced a new ornamental Design for Premium

 Cooking Stoves, and we do hereby declare that the following is an exact description of the same, To wit, Letter a, on annexed drawing is the foot. B, B, surface and end view of moulding around front hearth. C, C, surface and end view of Border around front of top. D, D, surface and end view of Border around back part of top. E, E, E, panels on sides and front with (Lamb and Harris) (Patent) and (Ohio Premium No. <sup>m</sup>) in the several panels as shown. F, F, upright panels on each side of front doors of similar shape and style to those marked E, except centre of panel, which is diamond shaped, checked with stars in centre and at crossings as shown. — G, G, G, are Gothic Doors, showing surface and end view when cut through the columns. H, H, surface and end view of arches when cut. — I, I, Base for columns, a square block with star in centre of each. J, J, surface and end view of corners of stove. —

What we claim as new and our invention is the combination and arrangement of the above represented and described mouldings, panelings and configurations into an ornamental design for Premium Cooking Stoves, and to be known and called as "Lamb and Harris' Patent Ohio Premium."
