

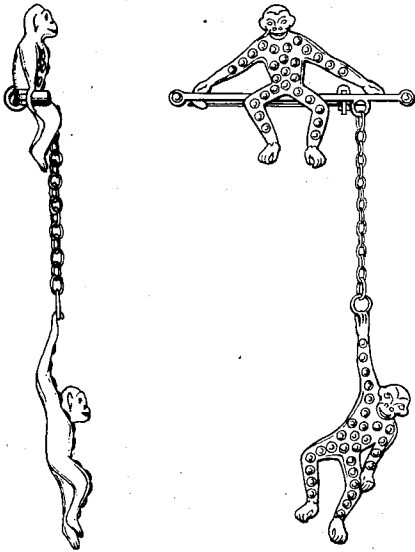

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Louis Ditchik, a citizen of the United States, residing in the Borough of Manhattan, city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Novelty Pin, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a novelty pin showing the new design; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.
