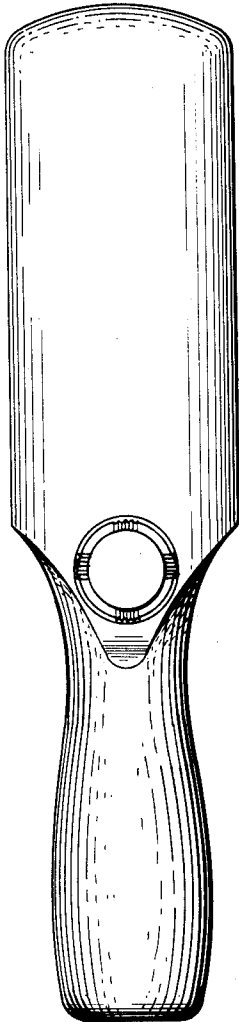

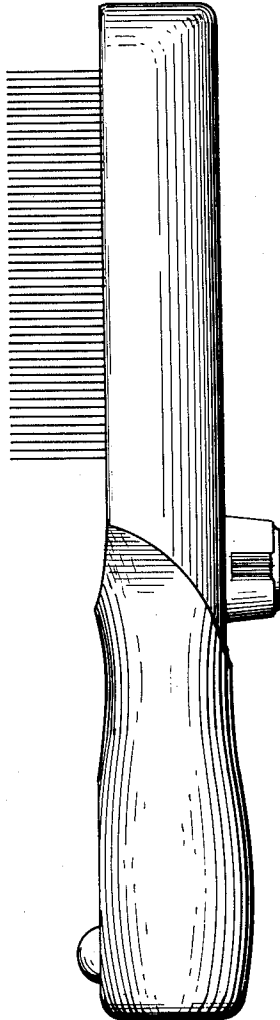
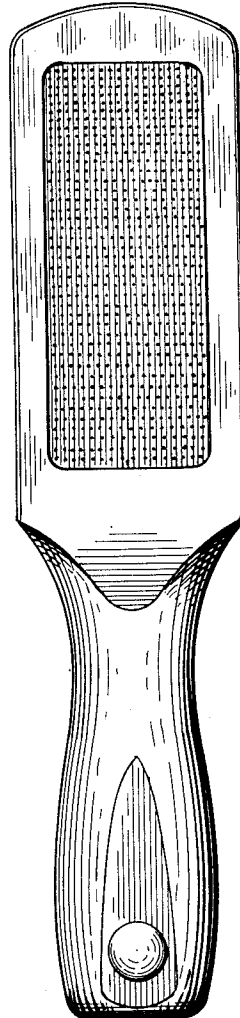

DESIGN FOR A HAIRBRUSH

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph S. Baddour, a citizen of the United States and residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hairbrush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:
